### **For Additional Study...this week spend some time with Ishmael**

Islamic tradition considers Ishmael the ancestor of Arab people, including Muhammad. Ishmael is the oldest son of Abraham through Hagar his wife's servant (Gen 16). Ultimately, Hagar and Ishmael are cast out (Gen 21:9-21), but Ishmael carried with him a blessing to become a great nation (Gen 17:20).

- *Think about how Arab Muslims are related to the Sons of Abraham.*

In Galatians, Ishmael and Isaac are used to illustrate bondage under the law and freedom in Christ. Read and reflect on Galatians 4:21-31.

- *How have Islamic teachings gone back to the bondage of the law?*
- *Think about how you have limited your spiritual life by trying to do things your way, rather than waiting for God's way in God's timing.*
