

COST MODEL RESOURCES

A cost model is an approach to measuring the true cost of implementing and maintaining a program or service compared to its revenue. Depending on how the tool is structured, it can provide cost variations attributed to policy changes, quality characteristics, and structural choices. The Children's Funding Project believes developing an effective, state- or community-specific cost model tool is a critical step in developing a strategy to close equity and opportunity gaps for children and youth.
