## Language Resources and How to Get Assistance

By responding to the census, you help your family and community get funding for essential services like schools, healthcare, and highways. Be counted!

✓ You can fill out an ONLINE CENSUS QUESTIONNAIRE in English, Spanish, Chinese (Simplified), Vietnamese, Korean, Russian, Arabic, Tagalog, Polish, French, Haitian Creole, Portuguese, and Japanese.

You can respond to the census online starting in March 2020.

✓ You can **RESPOND TO THE QUESTIONNAIRE by PHONE** in English, Spanish, Chinese (Mandarin & Cantonese), Vietnamese, Korean, Russian, Arabic, Tagalog, Polish, French, Haitian Creole, Portuguese, and Japanese.

You can call to respond to the census by phone starting in March 2020.

The Census Bureau will mail you a form in March or April 2020.
