The International Region is now a group of 7 international chapters, where Japan was the 4th to have been chartered. Student Program

AlA Japan's **Student Program** is now in its 6th year. Over the years, more than 20 architecture students from all over Japan have participated in this 3-week program and have seen first-hand what it is like to work in a US design. AlA Japan thanks program founder **Yasuyuki Yanagisawa**, who has once again coordinated the program this year.
