### Meet Our New Partner Family!

We are excited to announce our newest partner family, who will purchase the new home in Lebanon: The Harrington-Laundry Family!

William, Krystal, and their three sons (11 year-old Killian, 7 year-old Jameson, and 4 year-old Rory), own their own mobile home, but it is in very poor, unhealthy, and unsafe condition and there aren't enough bedrooms for everyone. They pay lot rent since they do not own the land the home sits on.

The eldest son, Killian, has severe special needs and is diagnosed with Level 3 Autism Spectrum Disorder, ADHD, and OCD. The two younger boys also have special needs, though not as severe.

"We thought Habitat was for other families and we might not have a shot, but we said 'why not apply and see?'" Currently living in a home with rotted floors, electrical issues, no hot water, and a failed heating system, the Harrington-Laundry's are excited to start building their home and investing in their future.

William, who works for Conifer Health Solutions, and Krystal, who works as a childcare provider, look forward to the stability of affordable homeownership, especially in terms of their children's health, more space for their boys, and for Killian in particular to have his own bedroom.

"We want something safe for our kids and safe for them to explore the outdoors. We love to be outside," says Krystal. Their current space doesn't have much of a yard and limited space for their children to run around, explore, and be children. They have longed for their own yard for their children to safely enjoy the outdoors and are excited that they will have three acres around their new home!

The extra space is something they had hoped for when they decided to become homeowners. As their family has grown, they have needed a safer space, more than their current home provides. Being in an older mobile home and in a community near a heavily trafficked road, their children's safety was a huge concern.

Now with some help from Habitat and a lot of help from supporters, William & Krystal are building a brand new three-bedroom home in Lebanon, NH. The home is set safely off Route 120 so their children can explore their property without worry of car traffic.

As William & Krystal prepare to become Habitat homeowners, they will take a home ownership course and also work one-on-one with Katy Almstrom of Almstrom Financial Consulting, who discounts her services for our partner families. "Financial education is going to really help us learn to be better prepared homeowners."

"We are so excited for this opportunity!" says Krystal, while clenching her husband's hand in excitement.
