choosing your colors

When it comes to color, choose colors that compliment each other rather than colors that match. Neutral colors compliment each other well and put more of the focus on you and your fiance, rather than what you are wearing.

Avoid patterns and really busy prints, as they are distracting and tend to clash easily with other outfit choices and even sometimes the location you are shooting at. It is also good practice to wear colors that compliment your skin tone.

If you have a darker skin tone, bright colors really make your skin pop.

If you have a lighter skin tone, jewel tones (examples below) are your best friend.

Be sure to pick something COMFORTABLE!! You will have a much better experience if you can move freely while posing and not constantly worrying about adjusting the clothes you are wearing.

A very helpful tip is to have two different outfits - perhaps one casual, and one a bit more dressy. Be sure to dress for the season, if it is cold, wear a coat. If it is summer, avoid adding too many layers.
