IN THE DAYS SINCE A BACKED up sewer main flooded homes with sewage in South Ozone Park, the city says it is stepping up to assist affected homeowners — but it wants help from other Queens residents. Advocates called on state lawmakers to enact the Child Victims Act in January. Three and a half months after the law took effect, 30 people have filed CVA complaints in Queens and 1,176 people have sued their alleged abusers statewide.

Nearly 1,200 people — including 30 in Queens — have sued their alleged abusers under the state's Child Victims Act

Nearly 1,200 survivors of sexual abuse across New York State have filed lawsuits against their alleged abusers under the state's landmark Child Victims Act, which took effect Aug. 14. At least 30 plaintiffs have filed complaints in Queens Supreme Court as of Dec. 2, according to data compiled by the Office of Court Administration.

Six Queens plaintiffs filed cases against their alleged abusers — and the institutions they say protected the abusers or looked the other way on the first day of the law, which provides a oneyear "lookback window" for survivors to file lawsuits, regardless of how long ago the alleged abuse occurred. Another 24 people have filed complaints in Queens in the ensuing three and a half months.

The number of Queens cases pales in comparison to the number of complaints filed in state Supreme Court in Manhattan (258) and Brooklyn (168), according to OCA records.

In the Bronx, 53 plaintiffs have filed complaints, while seven plaintiffs have filed complaints in Staten Island. **Continued on page 7**

Interviews to begin soon for next Queens Supreme administrative judge

State court officials have not yet selected a new judge to replace retired Justice Jeremy Weinstein as administrative judge in Queens Supreme Court, Civil Term, but interviews will begin soon, according to a spokesperson for the Office of Court Administration.

Since Weinstein retired on Aug. 30, Deputy Chief Administrative Judge for New York City Courts George Silver has served as acting administrative judge. In July, an OCA spokesperson said the agency expected to select a permanent replacement in the fall. That has not been the case, however.

The new top judge will be selected in the coming weeks, OCA said Tuesday.



Supreme Court Justice Marguerite Grays has expressed her interest in the role, including during her speech praising Weinstein at the Queens County Women's Bar Association holiday party last month.

"Now the time has flown by and you have left the court with big shoes to fill," she told Weinstein. "Thank god I'm a size 10."

Weinstein served as administrative judge at the Sutphin Boulevard courthouse for a decade. Continued on page 7

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New state law protects rent-regulated tenants from landlord harassment

Andrew Cuomo Tuesday will prevent landlords from harassing rentregulated tenants or fostering dangerous and disruptive conditions that compel them to move. Landlords throughout the city have attempted to drive out rent-regulated tenants through campaigns of attrition — not turning on the heat or making necessary repairs, for example — or by deliberately creating hazardous conditions, like conducting large-scale renovation proj-

A landlord who engages in that behavior against one tenant can now be charged with a Class A misdemeanor under the new law. Landlords who deliberately create unsafe conditions for two or more tenants can be found guilty of a Class E felony. The measure expands on existing law that protected tenants who demonstrated physical injury as a result of their living situations.

When tenants move out of rent-regulated apartments in buildings with fewer than six units, the vacant apartments revert to market-rate pricing, which means landlords can charge whatever the next tenant will pay. The lure of more rental income has incentivized some landlords to drive tenants out by fostering dangerous conditions "under the guise of necessary repairs," said Brooklyn Assemblymember Joe Lentol.

"The harassment of tenants in order to force them out so the landlord can raise the rent has been a rampant and unconscionable problem," Lentol said in a statement. "This bill will go a long way to protect tenants from such harassment and help keep individuals and families in their home."

State Attorney General Letitia James proposed the measure to prevent "unscrupulous landlords" from exposing tenants to deliberately dangerous conditions.

"Today that changes," James said. "Tenants will no longer have to meet an unreasonably high bar to demonstrate that they are being harassed. Instead, we will ensure that landlords will face justice."

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Broadway's Leslie Odom Jr. shows off his songwriting skills

He's sung Broadway tunes and he's done jazz standards. He's sung Christmas classics and a commercial jingle for Nationwide. Leslie Odom Jr. might be known primarily for singing other people's music but that's no longer the case.

The Tony- and Grammy-winner has released his first album of all-original material, the 13-track "Mr." When he recently performed a clutch of the songs to a live audience in New York he had difficulty explaining how it felt.

"I don't quite have words for it, but I will say it wasn't like anything that I've expressed before and I was thrown by it. I didn't know that it would feel that way," he said. "There's just something corseted when you're handling someone else's material." Now, he adds, "There's no corset."

"Mr.," with songwriting help from Rafael Casal, is a complex and fascinating collection of jazz, R&B and pop, featuring a vocalist able to purr one moment and soar the next. Odom said he felt that his third album had to encompass all his interests after putting out jazz and Christmas collections

"I did feel like this needed to be an introduction," he said. "That's why in part the styles are so varied, because that's what I like to sing. So, I really do feel like all of me is on this record."

The album is a family affair, with his wife, the stage and screen actress and singer Nicolette Robinson, providing backing vocals for four tracks and his grandmother, Eva Mae Odom, reciting Henry Wadsworth Longfellow's poem "A Psalm of Life."

Gleeful laughter is heard from his toddler baby, Lucy. Odom got the iPhone sound of dad tossing her into the air to be threaded into two songs.

"I wanted to include as much of my life and the people who make me who I am on some level. I wanted to sew them into the tapestry if I could," he said

Some of the highlights include the exuberant Broadway-ish "Hummingbird" (his daughter's favorite) and the thoughtful and complex "Remember Black," a sonic tour of the African American contribution to American culture. Then there are the songs that Odom clearly had his wife in mind "u r my everything" and "Go Crazy."

Odom said he gingerly asked his spouse to be part of the album. She was always the first person he shared his demos with, but he wasn't sure if she wanted to sing backup.

"My wife is a star," he said, laughing. "She's not the background in my foreground in any way. I didn't know if she'd be willing to sing background. I just wanted her to know, 'It's not that I think you're less. It's just that I want you there."

Odom's favorite song on the album is one he didn't write. It's not even a song, really - it's his grandmother's contribution. She had memorized Longfellow's poem in the fourth grade and her grandson would often ask her to recite it for him. He videoed her speaking it earlier this year in a hospital at the end of her life.

"It was the last time my grandmother ever read me that poem. And so I got to include her, too, which is so meaningful to me. That is my favorite track on the album. It kind of stops me dead

youngest person ever cast in the Broadway company of "Rent" at 17.

He made his breakthrough playing Aaron Burr in the original cast of the megahit "Hamilton." (In a weird twist, Odom's album comes out just as two of his "Hamilton" family - Daveed Diggs and Anthony Ramos - also put out new music.)

Odom will next appear in a prequel of "The Sopranos" called "Newark" and this fall costarred opposite Cynthia Erivo and Janelle Monae in "Harriet," the biopic of Harriet Tubman and her Underground Railroad safe houses.

"Harriet" has been criticized for everything from the casting of British actress Erivo (who happens to be godmother to Odom's daughter) to the film's supposed white savior narrative, prompting the creation of the hashtag #NotMyHarriet. Odom, who plays the abolitionist William Still, isn't bitter about the sniping and welcomes honest feedback.

"I understand people are protective over Harriet. They're protective over black stories because historically there's been such a historic lack of representation," he said.

"This is the first major motion picture about Harriet Tubman, but I don't think it'll be the last and there's no reason why it has to be the last. It doesn't have to be the definitive telling."

Odom plans to tour with the new songs next year and, in the spirit of "Harriet," hopes to hear from fans — about what they like and what they don't like. "I'm always willing to have people tell me the truth, but I hope that they do it in love. Tell me the truth about what I made."

NY Philharmonic to cut 500 seats in renovation

The capacity of the New York Philharmonic's much-maligned concert hall at Lincoln Center will be reduced by more than 500 seats as part of a \$550 million renovation that will cause the orchestra to relocate during part of the 2023-24 season.

Geffen Hall's reconstruction is slated for completion by March 2024, and \$350 million in funding has been raised, the Philharmonic and Lincoln Center said Monday.

Much of the hall's third tier will be eliminated, the number of rows in the orchestra cut from 43 to 33 and the auditorium floor slope increased. The stage will be moved forward 25 feet, allowing seven rows of seating behind the orchestra, part of the changes that will reduce capacity from 2,738 to under 2,200. The distance from the last row of the orchestra to the stage will drop from 119 feet to 92.

Space in the lobby and the grand promenade will be doubled as the box office and escalators are relocated. There will be additions of a media streaming wall in the lobby, a welcome center, a sidewalk studio for education activities and areas for art installations. There also will be new dining options and patron lounges.

Lincoln Center President Henry Timms and Philharmonic President Deborah Borda announced the plans during a news conference.

Construction will impact three consecutive seasons in a project called "Working in Concert." The hall will be closed from May to October in 2022, reopen with the stage shifted forward, then close again from May 2023 until February 2024. The Philharmonic will move a large chunk of its 2023-24 season to Carnegie Hall, its home from 1891 to 1962, and to New York City Center. The Mostly Mozart Festival will shift to other Lincoln Center venues in the summers of 2022 and 2023.

Opened in 1962 as Philharmonic Hall at a cost of about \$21 million and designed by Max Abramovitz with acoustics by Bolt, Beranek and Newman, the auditorium has been criticized for a sound that emphasizes brass and muddles lower strings.

Changes made during many summers includ-

ed adding reflecting panels on side walls, removing the original sound "clouds" and installing a stepped ceiling. The building was named Avery Fisher Hall after a \$10.5 million gift in 1973, and three years later there was a major renovation with the input of Cyril Harris, the acoustician for the praised Metropolitan Opera House next door. Another renovation in 1992, this time with Artec Consultants as the acoustician, included suspended panels.

Lincoln Center announced a \$100 million gift from David Geffen in March 2015 for a \$500 million renovation. Heatherwick Studio and Diamond Schmitt Architects were picked later that year for a project that was to start in 2019. Borda, hired in March 2017 to return to New York after 17 years with the Los Angeles Philharmonic, stopped that plan within six months.

Akustiks, led by Paul Scarbrough, is the latest acoustic designer. Diamond Schmitt Architects created the hall redesign, Fisher Dachs Associates the theater planning and design, and Tod Williams Billie Tsien Architects the reimagined public spaces.

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DART to SCAFFOLDING, which is more ubiquitous in New York City than in any other city in the world. Though the unsightly structures are meant to last for a maximum of three years, according to the city, some have stuck around for more than 20, New York Post columnist Miranda Devine pointed out recently. And though the plywood enclosures are designed to safeguard passersby from real hazards, like falling masonry, the makeshift structures can create safety hazards of their own, like forcing pedestrians into narrow tunnels where they become easy prey for muggers, or occasionally collapsing and injuring people below. The average 200-foot sidewalk shed costs \$12,500 for the original installation, and, once it's up, landlords often elect to simply keep the scaffolding in place rather than perform expensive repairs to their buildings' facades. We need laws that require building owners to take scaffolding down when buildings aren't under construction.

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LAUREL to COMMUNITY BOARD 7's Transportation Committee, which passed a resolution this year to ban free onstreet parking in its district in Manhattan. Parked cars take up 500 million square feet of public space citywide, sitting idle sometimes for days on end. Free parking incentivizes driving, adding to traffic congestion and to smog as drivers stop and circle in search of a spot. According to Curbed New York, the city has approximately 3 million street parking spaces, and just 5 percent are paid. This massive giveaway benefits a minority of households, 76 percent of which, in Manhattan, do not own a car. Charging for on-street parking would reduce demand, and thus driving, congestion and pollution, while raising money for sorely needed upgrades to city amenities like public transportation, that could improve life for more New Yorkers.

Lower Manhattan is already a hellscape on a typical weekday commute, without suddenly finding yourself an unwitting voyeur to some middle-aged couple's last-ditch attempt to spice things up. 



Hon. Silver and Chief Administrative Judge Lawrence Marks will conduct interviews with applicants and make the ultimate decision. OCA also talks with the

Erie County has accounted for the most CVA lawsuits in the state, with 288. Erie County is home to the Buffalo Diocese, the most-sued entity in the state. More than 210 plaintiffs have named at least 107 Catholic priests from the Buffalo Diocese in lawsuits alleging abuse, the *Buffalo News* reported last month.

Jayne Conroy, a trial lawyer and partner at Simmons Hanly Conroy who specializes in CVA cases, said observers should not read too much into the number of cases filed in specific jurisdictions just yet. The number of cases could "just be a function of research and schedules and deadlines" as survivors continue to learn about their rights and attorneys conduct research, Conroy said.

"It doesn't necessarily have any reflection on what the numbers may ultimately look like," she said. "We have until August so there's no reason to rush anything. We're doing our due diligence."

Conroy said media accounts of CVA cases play an important role in spreading the word about the law, and for making victims feel comfortable coming forward.

"It's very, very difficult for a victim to come for- dre

ward if they think no one has ever come out and said this person abused me, but then they see in the news that 10 people have come forward," she said.

In Queens, plaintiffs have forward, she said. In Queens, plaintiffs have filed civil, complaints against members of the clergy and individual churches in the Brooklyn Diocese, including priests at St. Margaret's Church in Middle Village and St. Francis Preparatory School in Fresh Meadows. Survivors have also sued Rockefeller University Hospital for not preventing abuse by longtime physician Reginald Archibald, who reportedly abused hundreds of children in his care.

The state court system designated 45 judges to hear cases under the CVA and has not had to assign additional judges, according to the Office of Court Administration.

In Queens, Justices Chereé Buggs and Laurence Love were initially designated to handle the CVA cases, but Acting Queens Administrative Judge George Silver, the deputy chief administrative judge for New York Courts, has stepped in to handle all New York City cases at the pretrial stage.

Conroy praised the way the court system has so far handled CVA cases.

"We've seen a tremendous response and efficiency from the court system in New York," she said. "It's been gratifying to see judges that have stepped in and recognized the significance of these cases, and the issues of compassion and empathy for the victims."

"Judges are rolling up their sleeves and saying 'How are were going to address this is an expeditious way?"



Lawmakers, activists denounce 'sweetheart deal' for major delivery firms

Queens Daily Eagle Lawmakers and environmental activists rallied on Cyber Monday against a preferential fine program that has turned into a "a sweetheart deal' for delivery behemoths like FedEx and UPS.

On paper, the Stipulated Parking Fine Program allows delivery businesses to waive their right to challenge parking tickets in exchange for a pre-set, reduced fine amount for each offense. In some cases, depending on the violation, the ticket may even be dismissed. Certain infractions — red light and bus lane camera violations are not eligible for reductions. The program offers the same deal for businesses that make pick-ups or service calls.

But in practice, the reduced fines give companies, such as FedEx, UPS, and Verizon a "free pass" to block bike lanes, fire hydrants, and crosswalks, while also increasing overall de-

livery traffic, say Public Advocate Jumaane Williams and Western Queens Councilmember Costa Constantinides. A report by Streetsblog found that fines of \$115 are often reduced to \$0 thanks to the program.

"Millions of packages bought on Cyber Monday will hit the streets over the next few weeks to create a safety nightmare," Constantinides said. "We have seen more than 50,000 bike lane violations over a twoyear period with little to no penalty for these companies. Frankly, it's sickening that we give delivery corporations a free pass to put people at risk."

In 2018, Constantinides was one of five councilmembers to introduce a legislative package that would abolish the Stipulated Fine Program, making it so that fines may only be reduced or dismissed on their merits following a hearing held by an administrative judge.

"Ending the Stipulated Fine Program will keep our cyclists and pedestrians safer, reduce the unprecedented traffic levels, and take useless, harmful truck exhaust out of our air," Constantinides added.

Williams noted that the Stipulated Fine Program is intended to prevent a backlog of cases in the city's court system, but argued that it loses the city millions in fine revenue. In 2012, an investigation by the New York City Comptroller's Office found that many companies partaking in the program failed to pay their fines there were 924 companies with outstanding fine amounts totaling \$7,729,458 registered in the Stipulated Fine Program, as of April 2012.

"The reality is, emissions from delivery vehicles are polluting our air, our roads are less safe because of double parking and illegal parking in bike lanes, and we're losing out in millions of dollars in fine revenue we could use to improve our city," Williams said.

City jail overseer urged to end solitary confinement after Layleen Polanco death

The city's jail oversight board should eliminate the use of solitary confinement at local lockups, Public Advocate Jumaane Williams urged Monday, saying detainees who act out can be separated but still treated humanely.

"We must end solitary confinement in the City of New York now," Jumaane Williams testified at the city Board of Correction's first public hearing on proposed changes to punitive segregation rules.

The board, which oversees city lockups, has proposed limiting stints in solitary confinement for most cases to a maximum of 15 days at a time, down from 30 days.

Williams objected, as did many others who testified. "Fifteen days in solitary confinement is 15 days too many," Williams said. "Through this rulemaking process, New York City has an opportunity to serve as a model for the nation in defending basic human rights."

The city's solitary confinement practices came under national scrutiny after the death of Layleen Polanco. The 27-year-old transgender woman was in the ninth day of a 20-day solitary confinement sentence when she was found lifeless inside her Rikers Island cell on June 7.

An Evolving Stance

After delivering prepared remarks, Williams said he did not initially believe it made sense to eliminate solitary confinement. "It took me a while to get to

this position," he said, noting he had "many conversations" before he fully understood the issue. "Moet folke understand if

"Most folks understand if there's problematic behavior, we do need to separate someone to get that corrected," he said. "But that does not mean we have to isolate them. That's is where the torturous behavior comes." Other jails and prisons that have drastically reduced the use of solitary confinement use bigger spaces to hold individuals who act out and boost social programming. They include the Middlesex County Adult Corrections Center in New Jersey, Nebraska Department of Corrections and the North Carolina adult correction and juvenile justice system.

New York City should similarly expand programs to include those who break jail rules, some Correction officials and jail union leaders have previously argued that solitary confinement is a necessary tool to maintain safety, and that eliminating it would lead to chaos. There are currently approximately 100 people in solitary confinement in city jails.

The Board of Correction has already scrapped punitive segregation for those under 22 and for people with serious mental illness. Since 2014, the number of people cal, physical and social harm," Williams testified. "It is an ineffective, counterproductive, and unsafe disciplinary practice that fails to address the underlying causes of problematic behavior." Some inmate advocates testi-

Some inmate advocates testified they are worried jail officials would find loopholes in the new rules to keep people in solitary for longer than 15 days.

Alex Abell, of the Urban Justice Center, said he was concerned new solitary restricrules were watered down following pressure from City Hall.

In October, Avery Cohen, a mayoral spokesperson, said the administration worked with the board and Correction Department "to formulate rules that protect the safety of our officers and everyone in our custody." "Our previous comments

DOC Silent at Hearing

Department of Correction Commissioner Cynthia Brann did not attend the hearing and no one from the department testified.

"A representative from the department was present at the hearing and we have been in continuous discussions with the board regarding the rulemaking process," said Peter Thorne, a DOC spokesperson. in solitary has dropped by about 80%, Correction Department records show.

More Harm Than Good?

Studies have shown solitary confinement can worsen pre-existing mental illness and cause inmates to develop medical issues. A 2014 analysis of New York City jails found solitary confinement was associated with self-harm and death.

"Solitary confinement is a torturous punishment that causes deep and permanent psychologitions do not apply to the Rikers' medical unit, known as the North Infirmary Command.

"It's a horrible place to be, and I don't think these restrictive housing rules actually address those housing rules," he said. Punishment is not the only

way to deter violence, he added. Some inmate advocates and

former board member Bryanne Hamill, a key reformer whose six-year term was not renewed by the de Blasio administration, contend the proposed provided us with a draft months in advance, allowing us to reach a mutually agreed upon set of rules that make the most sense for our facilities," Cohen added.

For instance, under the proposed rules, correction staff will be allowed to keep inmates shackled to desks by their feet for up to seven hours a day until the end of February 2022.

Critics blasted the board for allowing the desk restraints. "There is no reason to wait

"There is no reason to wait more than two years to end this cruel and inhumane practice," testified Daniele Gerard, a staff attorney at the nonprofit Children's Rights.

'A Lot of Work to Do'

Several advocates noted that a federal monitor overseeing official use of force in New York City's jails found that the DOC still hasn't reined in "hyper-confrontational" officers.

The federal monitor, Steve Martin, said in his October quarterly report that the frequency with which correction officers use force on inmates this year reached its highest level since he began issuing quarterly findings in 2016.

The proposed rules are currently undergoing a public review process that continues with a second hearing on Dec. 16. The board has the ability to change the proposed rules based on public feedback.

Board member Dr. Robert Cohen said at the hearing that the BOC "has a lot of work to do" and added, in response to a mother's testimony complaining about her son's "inhumane" shackling: "A lot of things you are asking for should be in the rule. I hope they end up back in the rule. Some of it just disappeared."

The hearing was held on the same day the de Blasio administration filed its land use application to officially prohibit jails on Rikers Island after Dec. 31, 2026.

The application is one of the first formal steps tied to the shut down of Rikers Island for four borough based jails.

"By guaranteeing that Rikers will never again be used for incarceration, we're charting a new course forward for the Island and the people of New York City," de Blasio said in a statement. "We're making good on our promise to close Rikers once and for all. Though mass incarceration may not have started here, we'll do all we can to make sure it ends here."

The Sexual Harassment Working Group praised Simotas for sponsoring the assembly version of the bill and said that "workers are now more safe at work" because of the new measures.

"We are so proud of the incredible 2019 improvements to discrimination laws, brought about by the hard work of our members and partner organizations," the Sexual Harassment Working Group said in a statement.

LIC man gets 25 years to life for brutal Ravenswood murder

A Long Island City man has been sentenced to 25 years to life in prison for gunning down a man in broad daylight at the Ravenswood Houses in 2017.

Javyn McNish, 21, was convicted in November of second-degree murder and second-degree criminal possession of a weapon. He was sentenced by Justice Kenneth Holder for the killing of Jerell Lewis, 20, in December 2017.

McNish was 19 when he spotted Lewis speaking to another man and began chasing him. McNish fired three shots — one bullet pierced Lewis' hand and a second struck his spinal cord, paralyzing him.

As Lewis lay dying, Mc-Nish stood over him and repeatedly pistol-whipped him with the weapon, breaking a tooth, prosecutors said. The 9mm semi-automatic pistol used in the shooting was recovered in an apartment that Mc-Nish could be seen running toward just moments after the shooting.

Holder handed down the sentence on Monday. The prison term will be followed by five years of post-release supervision.

Acting Queens District Attorney John Ryan said that McNish, "has been held accountable" following the sentence.

"He showed a total disregard and lack of respect for human life by viciously shooting a weapon while running in the streets. The punishment imposed today by the court is justified," Ryan added.

RECENT COURT DECISIONS AND APPEALS

By C. B. Abruzzese Brooklyn Daily Eagle DISCOVERY DEMANDS UNSATISFIED IN BREACH-OF-CONTRACT SUIT

Appellate Division, Second Department

In the Appellate Division, Second Department, Gozzer Corporation and Theodore Papakonstadinou appealed an order by Hon. Marguerite Grays of Queens County Supreme Court, Civil Term. The order granted the branch of Nikolaos Sparakis' motion to strike the answer and counterclaims as asserted on behalf of the defendant, Aktor Corporation. In an effort to recover damages, Sparakis and others had filed a complaint alleging breach of contract. In July 2016, the plaintiffs served the defendants with a request for the production of documents, to which they did

not respond within the required 20 days. In a compliance conference order dated March 7, 2017, the Supreme Court ordered the defendants to respond to the discovery demand by a specific date. The defendants failed to comply with the court-ordered disclosure date set forth in the preliminary conference order and the compliance conference order, and agreed to produce the documents requested in the plaintiffs' discovery demand by May 31, 2017. The stipulation further provided that in the event the defendants failed to produce the responsive documents by that date, the plaintiffs were permitted to move, without prior court approval, to strike the defendants' answer and counterclaims and to seek to enter a default judgment. On June 12, 2017, the plaintiffs moved to do exactly that. They contended that the defendants' document production was incomplete because none of the documents requested from Aktor was produced. In response, the counsel for Aktor indicated that the documents requested were "inadvertently omitted" and that Aktor was "in the process of collecting" the responsive documents. On Jan. 18, 2018, the Supreme Court granted the plaintiff's motion to strike the answer and counterclaims as asserted on behalf of Aktor. The defendants appealed and the justices of the Appellate Division, Second Department, affirmed the ruling of the lower court. They dismissed the appeals by Papakonstadinou and Gozzer Corporation because they were not aggrieved by the order that had been appealed and explained that the Supreme Court did not improvidently exercise its discretion in granting the plaintiffs' motion. Additionally, they noted that Aktor's willful and contumacious conduct could be inferred from its repeated failure to timely and fully respond to the plaintiffs' discovery demand, and the absence of an adequate explanation for its failure to comply with the deadlines set forth in the preliminary conference order, the compliance conference order and the parties' stipulation.

PASSENGER FREE FROM LIABILITY

IN MULTI-CAR CRASH

Appellate Division, Second Department

On Dec. 30, 2015, Venante Romain was allegedly injured in an automobile collision when she was a backseat passenger in a vehicle operated by Steven Freed and owned by HVS Management, Inc. The Freed vehicle, with Romain in the backseat, was struck in the rear by a dump truck operated by Hans Joseph and owned by the New York City Department of Transportation. Romain and her husband, suing derivatively, moved for summary judgment against the defendants on the issue of whether the injured Romain was at fault in the happening of the crash. In Kings County Supreme Court, Civil Term, that motion was denied. Romain and her husband then appealed in the Appellate Division, Second Department. There, the justices reversed the order of the Supreme Court and granted summary judgment on the question of Romain's fault in the happening of the crash. The justices found that the Supreme Court should not have denied Romain's motion. In their review of the record, the justices determined that, while both drivers involved in the collision submitted affidavits in which each maintained that they were free from fault, neither driver suggested that the injured Romain bore any fault in the collision. Also, in response to the defendant's assertion of a seatbelt defense, the justices explained that an alleged failure by Romain to wear a seatbelt was not relevant to the issue of liability but, rather, may "be introduced into evidence in mitigation of damages."

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Judge Phillip Hom sworn into state Supreme Court

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When attorneys who hope to one day become judges, like younger lawyers from the Asian Bar Association, ask him for him advice, Hom dispenses a few key pieces of wisdom.

"What I usually tell them is that a lot of becoming a judge is about temperament, experience and legal knowledge," he said. "Legal knowledge and experience are things they're going to have to get one day, but the thing to be careful with is temperament.

"It takes an entire lifetime to build up a reputation, but you can destroy a reputation in a few seconds," he added. "You have to learn to work with other attorneys, even attorneys who you don't like that much, but you have to be courteous and treat people the way you like to be treated."

Various judges and members of Queens' Chinese legal community also attended the event to celebrate Hom's election to the bench. Retired Supreme Court Administrative Judge Jeremy Weinstein, Queens County Democratic Party Executive Michael Reich, Queens Borough President and District Attorney-elect Melinda Katz each spoke.

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Judge Phillip Hom sworn into state Supreme Court

After two years on the Civil Court bench and a lengthy career in New York politics, Justiceelect Phillip Hom was sworn into the state Supreme Court at a special ceremony Tuesday.

Hom's wife Soo Yun, daughter Siena and several local leaders joined Hom at the ceremony. Former Second Department Presiding Justice Randall Eng administered the oath of office and the Asian American Bar Association of New York presented the robes. All Eng (right) administers the oath of office to Hom said he has felt supported by the judi-

cial community since first being elected judge in 2017. "When I first thought about becoming a judge, some judges told me it's a great job, but that it can be very isolating. Luckily, in my two years as a judge, I have not found that to be

true," Hom said after the robing ceremony. "Almost every judge, after meeting me for the first time, has told me to call them at any time, whenever I had any questions," Hom added. "That generosity is greatly appreciated." The Supreme Court bench is the latest step in a distinguished career for Hom. He spent several years in city politics, serving as chief of staff for his childhood friend John Liu, who was elected to the City Council in 2001 before becoming city comptroller. Liu is now a state senator and served

as master of ceremonies Tuesday. "We have an incredible individual who is not only worthy of becoming a justice of the New York State Supreme Court, but he is one that will serve with distinction, pride and honor," Liu said.

After working for Liu, Hom transitioned into a role as attorney for the Council's Committee on Transportation, where he drafted legislation and participated in oversight hearings of the MTA, the Department of Transportation and the Taxi and Limousine Commission.

A few years ago, local leaders suggested that Hom consider seeking a judgeship. The idea appealed to him and he began to pursue the bench. His experience in politics serves him well a judge, he told the *Eagle* earlier this year.
