2. The certification level for our organization is indicated below:

Organization: Designed for organizations that conduct up to 4-6 simulations per year within their direct agency/group)

Network: Designed for organizations that conduct multiple simulations per year within a defined network of partners- please list partners on page 4 of this MOA)

- Certification requires successful completion of the COPE Facilitator Training(CFT), including full attendance of all sessions for the entire CFT at which time the facilitator will have the opportunity to demonstrate proficiency and receive coaching on presentation of the COPE materials.
- 4. Certification will be effective through December 31 of the year after completion of CFT. At the end of each -year period, COPE Facilitators are required to participate in recertification process annually. Recertification fee is \$100 per person. Group Rates are available.

Intellectual Property

- 5. The CFT includes training regarding proprietary intellectual property owned by the Think Tank, Inc., including without limitation written materials; research and related data and analysis; training techniques; and oral presentations (the "Proprietary Materials"). I acknowledge and agree that the Proprietary Materials are the sole and exclusive property of the Think Tank Inc. and may not be used other than in accordance with the limited license described below.
- 6. The Proprietary Materials include copyrighted written materials. Certified Organization acknowledges and agree that they will not be permitted to photocopy or otherwise duplicate these Proprietary Materials. When using Proprietary Materials and concepts, Certified Organization agree to honor Think Tank Inc. copyright and other intellectual property rights associated with the Proprietary Materials by displaying the copyright on the material or citing the applicable material within the Proprietary Materials as the source of information using the name of the source material and assigning due credit.
- 7. Think Tank, Inc. reserves the exclusive right to publish and license, along with the right to reproduce, distribute, perform, and/or display, any derivative works arising from its Proprietary Materials which may be created by the Certified Organization, including any presentations, workshops, or other type of training.

Reporting and Materials Fees

- 8. We know that you are making a significant investment in COPE and want to know the real impact on your participants. For that reason, Think Tank has created an electronic survey and utilizes a data system to produce reports that will give you important feedback on participant experience, mindset shift and application.
- 9. COPE facilitators agree to participate in the survey/data collecting process as a part of their agreement with Think Tank.
- 10. Pre and post participant survey data entered into the COPE database within 30 days of each COPE Training.
