


Since our last update, discussions with the District of Squamish have continued and Council voted to defer the Boundary Extension discussion to 2020.

SNOW STUDY UPDATES



We have been collecting baseline data on the Brohm River water flows and received an updated Climate Data Analysis. This analysis compares values at Cypress and Whistler using new weather stations. The data shows much more snow on Brohm Ridge than in Whistler at similar elevations, although less than Cypress, since mountains closer to the ocean receive the most precipitation.


