Strong Background and Early Leader in Adaptation Policy and Education

Doug Parsons first started doing adaptation in Queensland, Australia, focusing on the impacts of climate change on the agriculture sector. Upon returning to the United States, Doug joined the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission and quickly assumed the duties of their first Climate Change Coordinator. In that position, **Doug developed a first-of-its-kind climate change course** that has since been modeled by the federal government and the state of California. He worked with some fantastic people in Florida, developing the framework for the science and planning teams that continue to do substantive work in the Sunshine State. Doug also contributed to various national initiatives, such as the National Fish, Wildlife, and Plant Adaptation Strategy.

As his career progressed, Doug's interests increasingly turned national, and he took a position as Climate Change Liaison with the National Park Service's Climate Change Response program. In that role, **Doug had the privilege of contributing to some of the earliest federal policy discussions around adaptation.** He later took the North America Policy Director role at the Society for Conservation Biology, working on climate change adaptation, endangered species, and science communication issues.


Today, Doug Parsons is the host of America Adapts. 
