

Student Visa

- Colour-scanned Passport
- Your Birth Certificate
- Evidence of intended study
 - E.g. a Confirmation of Enrolment (CoE)
- Evidence of appropriate accommodation, welfare and care
- Health insurance – this can be obtained at a later date
 - Evidence of adequate health insurance. Health insurance must be Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC). The OSHC must start from at least one week before the course starts and for the duration of the stay in Australia.
- Evidence of financial capacity
 - Evidence the applicant has sufficient to meet the following expenses:
 - Travel expense, and
 - Living costs and expenses of at least \$20,900.00 (known as the annual living cost), and
 - Course fees for the first 12 months of the period studying in Australia (minus any amount that has already been paid)
 - You will need to provide evidence that evidence that your parents are willing to support you and they have an annual income of at least AUD 60,000 in the 12 months immediately before the application is made. This can be provided through bank statements and evidence of employment (such as employment contract, payslips etc.)
- Evidence of English language ability
 - Depending on your type of enrolment, you may be asked to show evidence of English Language Ability.
 - You may choose to prepare this at a later stage. However, we do suggest booking the English test as soon as possible as it may take some to schedule
 - The minimum points required are:

English Test	Minimum Band Score
IELTS test	Overall band score 4.5
TOEFL iBT	Total band score 32
PTE	Overall band score 30
CAE	Overall band score 147

- Genuine Temporary Entrant requirement - This can include:
 - Evidence of assets in home country
 - Evidence of employment of parents in home country
 - Evidence of family in home country
- Evidence of change of name (if any)
