FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Why has IJRU decided to have assigned seats in 2023?

IJRU has partnered with Ticketmaster as part of our agreement with Robson Arena at Colorado College. With a nine-day IJRU event, and thousands of seats per day, this is a large undertaking and needs to be managed professionally. Also, this is the best strategy to open the event to new fans and spectators.

Why are there three phases of ticket sales?

We did this to make sure the jump rope community would have the first opportunity to get tickets, save money with a package and guarantee the ability to keep the same seat for the entire week! The first phase of tickets will be all-session passes, followed by Mini Passes and then single day ticket sales.

Are all ticket sales reserved seats?

Yes, this is a new approach for the IJRU so you can enjoy the same, reserved seat for the International Open Tournament, Junior World Championships, and World Championships for ticket purchases and fans. There is no "general admission" or open seating for spectators any of the three events. See below for information on athletes, coaches, officials and heads of delegation. All venue tickets are first come-first served for the best seats.

How much do tickets cost?

The price of tickets varies by the best seats in the venue. We also have Club Level tickets available. See the seating chart as part of the FAQ and the Ticketmaster venue map for exact prices of each ticket. The prices listed include the price of the ticket plus additional taxes and fees.

Are all the tickets on Ticketmaster or can I get tickets through the IJRU?

All tickets for the 2023 events (Junior World Championship, International Open Tournament, and World Championship) will be exclusively available on Ticketmaster.

What are the Club Level tickets?

The Club Level tickets are an upper level facing the center of the competition floor. The Club Level has access to its own private food and beverage service. That food and beverage is not included in the ticket price.

Are there VIP Suites available?

Yes, there are two VIP suites available for purchase and they can have custom catering of food and beverage. Please contact the IJRU if you are interested in one of the suites.

If I have event accreditation (also referred to as a credential), does that give me a ticket to the event?

All athletes, coaches, officials and heads of delegation will have access to the venue using their accreditation and have access to a designated seating area. Please refer to the seating map below. All other seats in the venue are reserved for fans and sold in advance of the event.

Can we block seats for our country?

People who purchase a ticket to the event may NOT block seats in the spectator areas. All tickets will be reserved seats. To sit together with a group or country, then tickets must be purchased at the same time for a particular section. See below for information on blocking seats in athlete, coach, officials' areas.

Can I purchase tickets when I get to Colorado Springs?

Yes, if tickets are still available. The best value tickets seats will be sold in advance through Ticketmaster. If additional tickets are available, they will be sold on-site at the venue and via Ticketmaster. Getting the packages early guarantees the best selection and availability. When seats go on sale, they will be sold on a first come first served basis.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

How do I receive my tickets?

All tickets will be delivered digitally through Ticketmaster to your mobile device. Tickets can be printed on the day of the event at the venue box office at Robson Arena. You can order tickets online and then pick them up on-site at Robson Arena. You must select that option when you order the tickets through Ticketmaster.

Is parking / carpark at the venue included in my ticket price?

Parking costs at the venue are still to be determined. There is also metered parking along streets near the venue.

Are there tickets to the second venue being used?

No. The El Pomar Center will be accessible for credentialed athletes, coaches, judges and heads of delegation who have purchased a daily fee.

What happens if I lose my tickets?

Digital tickets will always remain in your Ticketmaster account and easily accessible by your mobile device.

What if I have any problems with my tickets?

The box office will be open throughout select periods at Robson Arena with ticket personnel to answer questions.

Can I transfer my tickets to others?

Yes, the Ticketmaster app will allow you to email tickets.

If I purchase a ticket, can athletes/coaches/officials sit with me in the assigned seating without paying?

No. All purchased seats are assigned. Athletes, coaches and officials have been provided dedicated seating. This also includes IOT and Junior World Championships.

Can anyone sit in with the athletes, coaches, judges and head of delegation sections?

No, only credentialed participants may take a seat in the area dedicated for athletes, coaches, judges and heads of delegation.

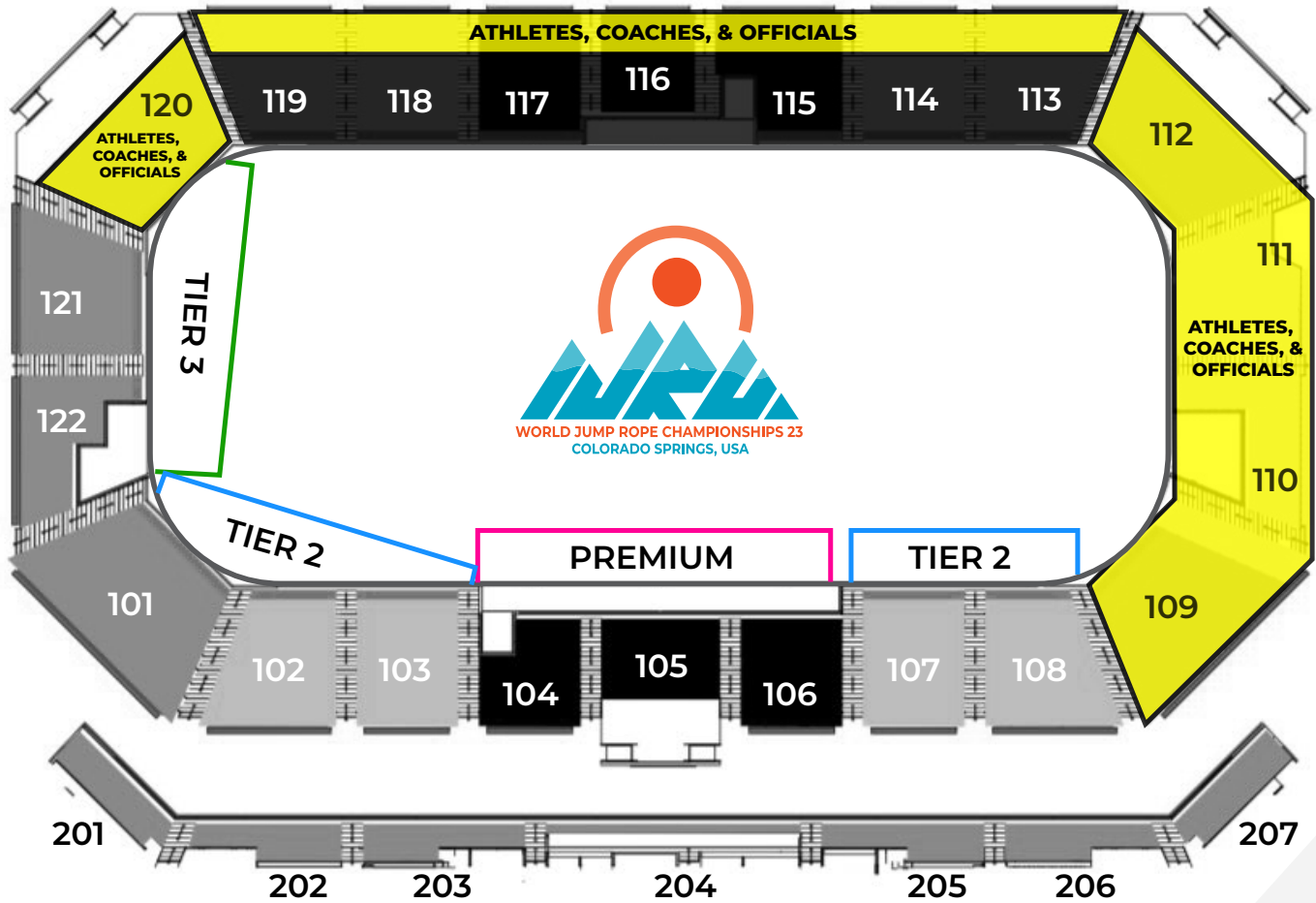
As an athlete, coach, judge or head of delegation am I guaranteed a seat?

The IJRU has ensured there are sufficient seats in the dedicated seating area to accommodate. See the venue map for specific sections.

Does my ticket give me access for the entire day?

Yes, tickets are sold for the entire day only. No individual session seats are being sold.
