- Non profit developers supporting local non profits with supportive and affordable housing partnership builds
- Launched 'Small Communities Initiative' BC wide as of August 2019

### 3. New Build Announcement - City of CR & CRNITS

- City of CR donating land on Fir St. for this project
- Campbell River & North Island Transition Society operating the building
- Funded through BC Housing
- Housing for women and children
- 40 units in the building
- Affordable, second stage housing is half of the units
- Long term rentals in second half of the units
- New housing agreement no less than 70% of the units will be rented at 'rent geared to income' for 30 years

## 4. City of Campbell River Update

- Council granted first round of Social Grants
- \$11 000 funded to the CRDCEH for coordination
- COuncil slated to discuss Secondary Suites on February 11th at the upcoming Committee of the Whole meeting
- MOUHSS (Mobile Outreach Unit for Health & Support Services) presenting to Council to get the outreach vehicle up and running to provide services
- Child care spaces report around 'space creation' and increased need in regards to poverty reduction and early years of 0-6
- Breakfast to release the <u>Child Care Report</u>- March 10th
- Community Wellness & Harm Reduction Grant "Get the Point" to engage and hire people with lived experienced around 'sharps' pick up in community
- <u>CMHC report released</u> Campbell River vacancy rates at .4% again this year, lowest on Vancouver Island and second lowest in BC



## 5. <u>BC Rent Bank</u> Resources

- VanCity Community Foundation & funded through the province
- Offering short term loans for security deposits, at flat rates or low interest rates with flexible payment options
- Offer advocacy and mediation
- To present to Coalition in spring around services
