**Chinese Gardens**  
Chinese immigrants planted truck gardens in this area in the late 1800s. The gardens have long since disappeared.

A Discover Pass is required for vehicle parking along the shoreline and at trailheads at Fort Worden State Park. Visitors are encouraged to purchase their one-day and annual passes on-site to avoid online transaction fees.

Passes (\$10 per day or \$30 per year) can be purchased at Fort Worden at the following locations:

- Bldg. 201 - Puget Sound Coast Artillery Museum
- Bldg. 210 - Fort Worden Commons
- Bldg. 501 - Cablehouse Beach Canteen
