WHAT IS WAREHOUSING AND DISTRIBUTION?

The Transportation and Warehousing sector includes industries providing transportation of passengers and cargo, warehousing and storage for goods, scenic and sightseeing transportation, and support activities related to modes of transportation.

Industries in Warehousing and Storage primarily operate warehouse and storage facilities for general merchandise, refrigerated goods, and other warehouse products. These establishments provide facilities to store goods. They don't sell the goods they handle. They may also provide a range of logistics services related to the distribution of goods. Logistics services can include labeling, inventory control and management, light assembly, packaging, and transportation arrangement.
