

# EXPLORE WAREHOUSING



## SHIFT OPERATIONS MANAGER

**What they do:** Plan, direct, or coordinate transportation, storage, or distribution activities. They also act in a leadership role for workers on shift, and monitor inventory, quality, and other aspects of supply chain management.

**How to get there:** Generally requires a bachelor's degree

**What they make:** \$32.53/hour



## MATERIAL HANDLER

**What they do:** Work to move freight, stock, luggage, or other materials, or perform other tasks in a warehouse or logistics environment.

**How to get there:** Requires a high school diploma or less.

**What they make:** \$14.58/hour

## OPERATIONS MANAGER

**What they do:** Operations Manager are usually responsible for the warehouse facility as a whole, including overseeing decisions and processes that make the facility work efficiently and safely.

**How to get there:** Requires a master's degree.

**What they make:** \$41.61/hour



## DISTRIBUTION SUPERVISOR

**What they do:** Distribution Supervisors directly supervise and coordinate the work of material movers, helpers, and laborers within a logistics environment.

**How to get there:** Requires a post-secondary certificate or associate's degree

**What they make:** \$29.05/hour
