Tools and Materials

- Drill, wood drill bit, screw driver bits
- Saw (miter saw or skill saw)
- Level
- Cement footers
- 4x4x8
- 2x6x8
- 2x4x8
- 2 cement footers for 4x4
- 10" bolts
- 3" screws
- Goggles
- Gloves



Safety

- For this project I have precut materials and scaled them down to a smaller garden arbor. For a full scale arbor you may need two people.
- Wear safety goggles when making any cuts and drilling out your wood products.
- If you are not familiar with the tools needed ask for help.
