

May 4, 2020 – Special Meeting

A special meeting of the Gardiner Town Board was held this afternoon at 3 PM. This meeting was conducted on Microsoft Teams as a virtual meeting. Present were Supervisor Majestic, Councilmen Carucci, Dukler & Wiegand and Councilwoman Walls along with Code Enforcement Officer Andy Lewis and Town Clerk Michelle Mosher. There were approximately 44± audience members.

The purpose of this special meeting is to discuss campground licensing. Code Enforcement Officer Andy Lewis prepared a letter to the Yogi Bear/Lazy River Campground addressing license requirements of the campground. Supervisor Majestic read the letter to the Board. All Board members support the letter.

Board members discussed the licensing process at length. Councilwoman Walls suggested a provisional license approval to a final license once all is complete. Attorney Allyson Phillips stated that our law does not allow for provisional licenses. She suggested to authorize the campground to operate while under review.

A motion was made by Councilman Wiegand, seconded by Councilwoman Walls and carried, to accept the Code Enforcement Officer's letter dated May 4, 2020 and authorize him to send it out. The Town Board modifies the action taken at the May 1, 2020 meeting by authorizing the issuance of this letter notifying Lazy River Resorts of the requirement to apply for a license.
