



JOB DESCRIPTION: Head Women's Volleyball Coach

Position Summary: The Head Women's Volleyball Coach is responsible for initiating and administrating all aspects of the program including but not limited to recruiting, scheduling of team activities and competition, training, academic monitoring, budget monitoring, and fundraising.

Accountability: Head coaches report to Director of Intercollegiate Athletics.

Qualifications: Bachelor's degree required, master's degree preferred. A strong commitment to the Student-Athlete concept and a working knowledge of NCAA rules and regulations is required. Three to five years of coaching experience at the college level is preferred. Strong leadership, communication, coaching and recruiting skills are required. Candidate must endorse the mission of Ohio Valley University, a school associated with churches of Christ.

Essential Functions: The Head Women's Volleyball Coach will direct every aspect of this collegiate athletic program. That direction will include at least the following:

- Provide mentoring and spiritual direction to student-athletes
- Maintain an acceptable roster of student-athletes as determined in consultation with the Director of Athletics;
- Direct the strength, conditioning, and skill training of the student-athletes in the program;
- Plan and coordinate effective team practices in preparation for the program's competitions;
- Schedule an acceptable number of athletic contests each season as outlined by national and conference policy;
- Plan Team travel;
- Serve as game coach for each contest;
- Coordinate fundraising activities to support the program financially;
- Manage the program's budget in cooperation with the OVU Business Office;
- Effectively manage coaching and support staff;
- Represent Ohio Valley University and the Women's Volleyball program in a professional manner consistent with the mission of Ohio Valley University.
