Pick 2 Scholarships*

Academic

High school students with at least a 21ACT/1060SAT and a 3.0 GPA or higher. Transfer students with at least a 3.25 college GPA.

Alumni Legacy

Students whose parents graduated from OVU, OVC, or Northeastern Christian Junior College are eligible for \$2,500 per year.

Athletic

Be in touch with an OVU coach for more details.

Child of Minister

Students who are the children of a paid full time minister could be eligible for a \$3,000 scholarship per year, up to 4 years.

Congregational Scholarship Match

OVU will double what any congregation offers (up to \$5,000 per year from OVU).

Express

Scholarships are available for members of Express. Selections are determined by audition. Visit ovu.edu/express for more details!

Faith-Based High School

Wood/Washington County \$6,000 per year, up to 4 years;
Outside Wood/Washington Counties \$4,000 per year, up to 4 years.

Mid-Ohio Valley Grant

\$5,000 scholarship available, up to 4 years, to students who have graduated from a surrounding county high school (Wood, Pleasants, Ritchie, Wirt, Jackson WV, or Washington, OH).

Additional Scholarships

Bible

Club Captain

\$1000 a year, up to 4 years (one per club for Ultimate Frisbee, Cheerleading, etc). App deadline is March 15th of HS senior year.

Early Acceptance

Apply and be accepted by Dec. 31 of HS senior year to be eligible for a \$1000 scholarship, freshman year only.

Performing Arts

Presidential Leadership

Awarded to 3 qualified, outstanding incoming freshmen per year. Apply with Admissions by March 15th of your senior year!

Trustee's Academic

Full ride scholarship for tuition, room, and board (fees not included) to one incoming freshman per year with at least a 30 ACT or 1380 SAT and a HS GPA of 3.5 or higher. Must submit an application, essay, and reference to the Financial Aid Office by March 15th of your senior year!
