Friday, May 26

Join us early for our Media Day Kite Show at noon on the beach on the south side of the Wildwoods Convention Center for the traditional unlocking of the summer season! In the afternoon, event registration opens at 4:00pm at the Festival Field tent on the beach at Rio Grande Ave. *A reminder to all Kite fliers – everyone must register and sign the waiver to fly on our fields or at indoor flying.* This is imperative in protecting the AKA insurance policy. Registration will remain open until 6:00pm. If you miss registration on Friday, registration continues on Saturday beginning at 8:00am at the Festival Field tent on the beach at Rio Grande Ave. Kite sales will be taking place at the Festival Field tent and will be open along with sales of event merchandise beginning today! Cash and all major credit cards accepted.

At 6:00pm, join us for the Friday Night Welcome Social located at our host hotel, poolside. At 9:00pm, the annual Nite Kite Show is held on the beach at Rio Grand Ave. Bring your strobes, spotlights and your kites!





Saturday, May 27

NEW for WIKF 23, our quad-line kite flyers will engage in varied scheduled activities such as team flying, stack flying, mystery ballet and, while we do have a Learn To Fly field which includes four-line kites, our very own quad-line performers are opening up a one hour time slot on Saturday and Sunday for the public to step on to the beach and try THEIR kites!

Why not try out some other fun events geared towards introducing new folks to our sport – join us at the Learn-To-Fly Field, Candy Drop and the Running of the Bols – for kids and adults!. C'mon down off the boardwalk and be a part of the events!

Returning is this year's 12th annual Scott E. Spencer Memorial Wildwood Kitemaker's Competition, sponsored by the South Jersey Kite Flyers! *For the third year running, once again this year's entrance fees are being sponsored by an anonymous donor in conjunction with Sky Festival Productions* in the spirit of encouraging new kite makers to participate – so take advantage of that, join in and sincere thanks anonymous donor, your gracious gift in doing this is very much appreciated!

Competition will be in three categories: Judges' Choice, Kitemakers' Choice and Novice. All entries will be flown together at the designated time. All judges and kite makers will walk from kite to kite together, with each kite maker being given a short time to discuss their kite and reel it in to show off any special parts (the idea is for kite makers to learn from each other). After all kites have been seen, the judges will choose a winner for Judges' Choice and the competitors will vote for Kitemaker's Choice.

Each 1st place winner of the judges' Choice and Kitemakers' Choice will receive a \$100 cash prize. The top Novice Kitemaker wins memberships in both the AKA and SJKF. All prizes are sponsored by SJKF!

All kites must be handmade by the entrant. No proxies. Multiple entries are permitted for one entry fee. Please note that our definition of novice is anyone making kites for three years or less who has not won an award at any other competition in a previous year.

The **WIKF Auction** will be held on Saturday night in the Ballroom at the Convention Center and *is open to the public!* Our Silent Auction begins at 7:00pm and the Loud Auction begins at 8:00pm. Remember, the auction supports the festival so please support the auction – **cash and credit cards accepted!** Donations are welcome, very much appreciated and may be shipped in advance or hand delivered at registration. 
