



Construction (Design and Management) Regulations (CDM 2015)

The Construction (Design and Management) Regulations (CDM 2015) are the main set of regulations for managing the health, safety and welfare on construction projects. CDM applies to all building and construction work and includes new build, refurbishment, repair and maintenance. If you are working for a domestic client, you will be in control of the project and take on the client responsibilities if you are the only contractor; the graphic below sets out the simple steps you need to take to ensure compliance.

A written construction phase plan is required for every construction project. This does not need to be complicated and mobile apps such as the CITB's CDM Wizard for Apple¹ or Android² devices can simplify the process, or if you are not technically minded, the HSE have a construction phase plan³ template which can be downloaded.
