FOUNDATION PROGRAMS:

Partners in Education: The Foundation receives ongoing support from local businesses who provide event sponsorships, and who donate time, money, and other resources to assist with a variety of school projects, including academic programs as well as intramural athletic programs and events.

Classroom Mini Grants: Teachers are able to apply for educational enhancement funds in the form of mini-grants, which range from \$50 - \$500. These monies are used to purchase programs and/or materials for innovative or special classroom programs which will enhance the educational experience of their students.

Student Fellowships & Scholarships: Through the generous contributions of community donors, the Foundation is able to offer scholarships for graduating seniors, as well as Fellowships for secondary students.
