We have committed to fund childcare, and last semester we were able to give them the 11K or the 18K we committed at the beginning of the year. In terms of what Joe (past treasurer) allocated, we have raise both levels of social events and scientific events, so it does makes sense to move money from one line to the other one if it is in the benefits of the graduate student population.

Roger: Yes, there is a lot of money that goes to the floor 6 of the Life Sciences Building for the department of Ecology. There seems to be a club that operates and requests for the same amount of money to the GSO as the department does.

<u>Abby</u>: The physical anthropology are the people running the club, so it includes other 2 disciplines like Anthropology, Psychology or the Political Science. Therefore, it makes sense that we should give money to these clubs.

Roger:
