Every election cycle, political observers diligently follow campaigns throughout the region and impatiently await the ultimate results. Afterward, a few moments are spent looking at the initial results; once winners are declared, most observers understandably move on.

This document is an attempt to re-focus attention on the 2022 election with as much context as possible. That means looking at final vote totals – numbers that most people stopped paying attention to around Thanksgiving while votes continued to be counted – along with taking stock of how candidates performed relative to their voter registration and the partisan performance of candidates higher on the ballot. It also means considering the full scope of money spent in each race, which obviously often correlates to electoral performance.

By aggregating this data and attempting to put it into context, it's my hope that there will be a greater understanding of how voters viewed their candidates for local office and the issues that were most important this election cycle.

What's included in this analysis

The bulk of this analysis examines non-partisan races throughout San Diego County for County and City offices. Elections with only one candidate were excluded from the meatier part of the analysis, but data for nearly every election and jurisdiction is available in the appendices.

Each election analyzed includes:

- Party registration breakdown as of Election Day
- Turnout and performance by Governor & U.S. Senate candidates within the district
- Results of the election, including vote totals, percentages, margins of victory, and a breakdown of performance for each candidate among Early, Election Day, and Late ballots
- Candidate fundraising and spending totals (Note: These numbers are aggregate for the entire cycle, meaning they include primary election fundraising numbers for those candidates who had a primary)
- Independent expenditures / Party Member Communication in opposition or in support of candidates. Elections that did not see any independent expenditures will obviously not include this data.

The Appendices include:

- Voter registration data as of Election Day for City and School Board elections
- A breakdown of every election on the ballot by percentage, vote total, margin, and a breakdown of performance for each candidate among Early, Election Day, and Late ballots
- A breakdown of partisan performance (Governor & U.S. Senate) by City and County districts

Sources:

- Voter registration data were provided by Political Data Inc. and sourced from the San Diego County Registrar of Voters
- Data from the Elections were provided by the San Diego County Registrar of Voters

- Fundraising data were available on the reporting portals for the various jurisdictions included in this report, or via the City Clerk offices for these jurisdictions

TRENDS & OBSERVATIONS

The Partisan Mail Ballot Divide

The last two Election cycles have presented a new paradigm for San Diego County voters: all voters now receive a ballot in the mail automatically. While a significant majority of voters had already received their ballot via mail prior to COVID, November 2020 and November 2022 now provide two examples of 100% mail ballots.

However, while mail ballots had historically favored older, more conservative voters, the trend has effectively reversed itself over the past two cycles. Now, it's the more left-leaning voters who prefer to vote by mail, while conservatives tend to prefer voting in person, either by dropping off their mail ballot at a vote center, or dropping it off at a polling location on Election Day.

And of course, we have the data to prove this! Below is a snapshot of five partisan races, each of which had competitive and close elections between a Republican and Democrat. They include two Assembly races, two Senate races, and a Congressional race. While some are only the San Diego County portion of the district, they still provide insight into voting patterns.

As a refresher, "Early" refers to ballots that were already at the Registrar's office before the polls open, with the cutoff this year likely being the Saturday before the Election. These are effectively the results that showed at 8:01pm on Election Night on the County Registrar's website. "E-Day" (Election Day) refers to in-person votes that were cast on Election Day and don't come in by-mail envelopes and don't require signature verification. "Late" refers to votes that arrive on Election Day, either via mail or via drop boxes, or those ballots that arrive after Election Day.

As you can see, the Early vote tends to lean Democrat, while the Election Day vote is significantly Republican. The late vote trends even more Democrat than the Early vote – a bit of a throwback to past cycles where Democrat votes tended to come in toward the end.

When analyzing local election results, this partisanship model still applies. It can be interesting in a few ways when it comes to interpreting results, but here is one of the more notable ways to view these numbers:

In races where that only feature Democrat vs. Democrat or Republican vs. Republican, these numbers should indicate which candidate voters perceived to be the most progressive or conservative. In many cases, outside observers could already make this guess. But for down ballot races, it may be of interest to try to detect how voters perceived candidates.

As an example, here is the race for San Diego City Council, District 6. This race featured two competitive Democrats, Kent Lee and Tommy Hough. Observers of the race are aware that Lee portrayed himself as the more moderate/conservative option, and it appears that message worked, as Kent was able to win a significant share of the Election Day (which is significantly comprised of Republicans):

Republican Performance

One of the key trends this document reveals is the fact that many Republicans running for non-partisan, local offices almost uniformly outperformed the partisan candidates for Governor and U.S. Senate.

This trend is easiest to spot in the campaigns where only two candidates were on the ballot: one Republican and one Democrat.

While there were certainly exceptions to this trend, the trend remains firm.

For example, John McCann (R), in his victory over Ammar Campa-Najjar (D), outperformed Governor candidate Brian Dahle (R) by about 12 points.

Jim Desmond (R) outperformed Brian Dahle by about 9 points.

In their unsuccessful campaigns as Republicans, La Mesa Mayor candidate Kristine Alessio and San Diego City Council District 2 candidate Linda Lukacs outperformed Dahle by around 4 points.

On the extreme side of the scale, San Marcos Mayor Rebecca Jones outperformed Dahle by a whopping 16 points.

There are a handful of reasons this may have played out:

- At the local level when dealing with local issues, voters leaned a bit more conservative. It's likely local candidates were able to tap into these local concerns more effectively, whereas partisan top-of-the-ticket candidates were more weighed down by partisan baggage.
- This is the first cycle since 2016 without the presence of Donald Trump either on a ballot or in the White House. Accordingly, local candidates – who in past cycles may have been linked to Trump either naturally or through campaign messaging – were unencumbered by Trump's unpopularity among moderate voters.
- The fact that the races at the top of the ticket weren't heavily funded nor drew attention. Had Dahle been able to mount a more significant campaign (especially relative to Newsom), he likely would have picked up more non-partisan voters. And Mark Meuser presents an even more extreme example of

this. That being said, many local candidates did not run very aggressive campaigns yet were still able to perform better than the top of the ticket.

What I thought might be interesting would be to try to quantify the extent to which some of these local Republicans were able to appeal to Democrats and DTS.

In order to try to quantify this, I've developed a crude model that I call the "Crossover Score." It's reliant on some assumptions and doesn't account for the entire context of a race (namely money), but can still be an interesting data point if taken alongside the many other data points available to evaluate a given election.

The calculation is mostly straightforward:

$$\frac{((\text{Republican candidate vote share} - \text{Republican voter registration}) / \text{DTS registration})}{1} \times 100$$

(You could also run this calculation for Democrats of course, simply using their vote share and Democrat voter registration.)

Essentially, the calculation assumes the Republican receives 100% of the Republican vote, and then asks what % of the DTS vote the candidate would win over.

Now, a Republican isn't going to get 100% of the Republican vote. It just doesn't happen. However, it's also likely they receive some Democrat votes. So this isn't a literal calculation to determine the exact % of DTS votes a Republican gained. It's more of a loose mechanism for determining how much appeal a Republican candidate had beyond registered Republicans.

Here is a chart of nearly every election for City Council or Supervisor where a lone Republican faced a lone Democrat. The list shows the Republican candidate, and what their "Crossover Score" is, along with the outcome of their election:

Now, a score above 100 implies the candidate was basically able to win all Republicans, all DTS, and some Democrats. Of course, the actual outcome was messier than this, with some Democrats voting for the Republican, some Republicans voting for the Democrat, and DTS voting for both (but leaning heavily toward the Republican on balance). But if you follow and only follow the formula, then the raw numerical output says it's a clean sweep across 2/3 voting groups.

As an aside, I also want to note that it's my presumption that the DTS vote leans a bit more conservative. Keep in mind, a core reason the Republican registration has fallen so much over the past few years is former Republicans have defected to DTS. While this means they are no longer registered partisans, it's unlikely they completely abandoned their conservative leanings, especially at a local level.

Accordingly, when evaluating these scores, my own instinct tells me that a Republican candidate who picks up only 50% of the DTS vote above Republican registration (basically a Crossover Score of 50) did not do a particular good job of appealing across parties relative to their opponent. I'd say that a score in the 70s is probably the baseline for what to hope for as a Republican, and the more you perform above that, the more impressive the performance.

I would argue that before jumping to any rapid conclusions, you should take each race into proper context. For example, Keith Blackburn's opponent had far fewer resources at their disposal relative to Blackburn, which is going to tip the scales a bit more in Blackburn's favor relative to a more typical election. (That being said, Blackburn still

needs to be credited for running an aggressive campaign and deterring a more significant challenge.)

My final caveat is this is a relatively small sample size, and that this model is mostly just a way of making use of the limited data we have in a more creative way. However, it may be an interesting way of evaluating election outcomes moving forward. Or not.

If you are a candidate or just a person interested in exploring this concept more, you can reference the Appendices at the end of the document to run your own calculation. I mention again that this only really works for races that are a clean D vs. R matchup, and the math would get too messy and cloudy for elections with more than two candidates.

Who spent the money?

It's no surprise that the San Diego County Democratic Party is the top spender, as they spent close to \$1 million between Member Communication and independent expenditures. (Again, this is only money from the local races analyzed in this document. It does not include what they might have spent in school board or other races.)

The Republican Party of San Diego County spent about 1/3 the amount of the local Democratic Party when it comes to member communication.

The majority of the San Diego County Democratic Party's expenditures were toward Ammar Campa-Najjar (\$190,225.50), Jennifer Campbell (\$108,911.44), Nathan Fletcher (\$100,882.82), and Cipriano Vargas (\$100,362.82).

For full context, here is the aggregated expenditure data for the races analyzed below. This is not all spending in all races across the county, just the local races for County and City offices analyzed below. I have attempted to crudely classify each committee as either center, left, or right based on their spending habits either historically or in this specific election:

Party Breakdown by City

Following the 2022 General election, 9 of 18 City Councils have Democrat majorities, while 7 of 18 have Republican majorities.

Two City Councils don't have any clear majority. In one case (Carlsbad), that result is due to a vacancy. The other City Council, Imperial Beach, has two NPP members and two Democrat members.

Four cities currently have vacancies: Carlsbad, Chula Vista, Encinitas, and Escondido. All of those cities except Carlsbad have a ruling majority that should theoretically be able to come to consensus on an appointment.
