PASTOR'S NOTE

Dear Saints,

SEPTEMBER - NEW MASSBOOK OPENING

The month of September is our Mass Book opening month for Masses in 2022. Using the Mass intention form found online or in the church vestibule, any parishioner is able to submit requests during this period for up to three Masses to be said in 2022. Requests submitted by September 30 will receive priority treatment for 2022. There is a \$10 stipend per Mass requested, with each parishioner making up to three requests during the month of September.

The parish staff will work to resolve conflicts in requested dates for Mass. When a first preference is not available, an alternate date taken from what you've indicated on the form, will be used.

October will be a blackout period for mass requests for 2022 so that the requests submitted by September 30 can be recorded.

Mass requests for 2022 will resume once again in November. Through the www.olmc.church website, you will be able to view a calendar showing all of the intentions received during the opening month. If you wish to make more intention requests, you are welcome to do so at that time and throughout the remainder of the year.
