Main Goal

New Covenant School's mission is to "present our students complete in Christ." We recognize that all knowledge comes from God alone, therefore we are committed to integrating His truth revealed in Scripture into every aspect of our school. Whether in the classroom, chapel or on the play ground, every moment is a teaching moment and a chance for the students to learn about the love of God. This commitment of teaching Christ in all things starts in our youngest class, the K2 class. Yes, the students in the K2 class are only 2 years old, which is a great time to begin filling their minds and hearts with truth from God's Word and laying a foundation that will last them a lifetime. In our classrooms we have age-appropriate high expectations for our students, to guide them in the paths of righteousness as they grow and mature.

Quality

Our program is institutionally focused as a preschool, and operates as a foundational step to our grammar and high school. Our program is not just a daycare, but offers so much more to our community as we raise up the next generation. Our teachers operate in a safe facility and structured classroom environment. The student to teacher ratio is low, so each student gets the quality attention he, or she, needs.

Life Skills

What can a 2 year old learn in a classroom? So many things the list could go on and on. As children grow and develop their minds are like a sponge, so now is the time to fill that sponge with truth and skills that will benefit them their whole life. We use our classroom time to teach them verses and truths about God, such as God is everywhere and He is with us always. Skills we work on are self-control to stay on our spot for rug time and table time, loving others by sharing toys, being respectful to others while walking quietly in the hallway, personal hygiene of hand washing, learning to use the restroom, number and letter recognition, using our words to express what we would like to say, fine and gross motor skills, participating during the chapel singing, sitting still and quiet during a chapel lesson, and much more. Our desire is to give our students the tools they need to be a Christ-follower and to be life-long learners. Ultimately we know God is the one that has to do the work to change the hearts of our students; removing the heart of stone and replacing it with a new heart (Ezekiel 36: 26). The life skill of sitting still does not come naturally to a 2 year old, but when it is learned it is beneficial for a life time. Being able to sit still will help in church, waiting at the doctor, maybe working a desk job one day and with personal daily devotion.

Parent Benefit

New Covenant is here to assist parents in teaching and training their children for the Lord, not to replace the role as the parent. Another benefit of our preschool is it provides a regular time for parents to have four hours during the morning to accomplish tasks without interruption. While your toddler is at preschool it is a great opportunity to have doctors appointments, breakfast dates, clean the house, grocery shop, etc.
