New Covenant School offers a variety of Honors, AP, and Dual Enrollment classes.

Students who are transferring to New Covenant School from another school or home school may receive credit for work completed previously when NCS receives documentation of their previous work. The Head of School is authorized to accept this work toward NCS graduation requirements provided the work is of similar nature, i.e., similar course objectives and similar time of study. Credits may come from dual enrollment.

ONE THREE HOUR DUAL ENROLLMENT COURSE EQUALS 1 NCS CREDIT.

In order to graduate from NCS, Seniors must be enrolled in five credits of approved coursework. Seniors are required to take Rhetoric, a Bible class, Life Skills, and do a Senior Project at NCS. Seniors must also take at least one of the following courses at NCS: Government & Econ, Probability and Statistics, Math Survey, Physics, or Spanish. 3½ total credits must be taken on site at NCS.
