## 7. SCORING

7.1 For the results of the Cup Series:

- A high-point scoring system will be used where the boat accumulating the most points wins
- A boat's final score for each regatta will be based on a 100-point scale, inverted. For example, if a boat wins a 25-boat regatta the winner will be awarded 100 pts., second place will earn 99 pts., and so on.
- A boat attending an event and scored DNC will be scored 0 pts.
- A boat not attending an event will receive 0 pts., and not be scored.
- The ranking of the Cup Series will be calculated by adding a boat's <del>best three</del> two individual event scores. A boat attending four or five events will be allowed throw outs.
