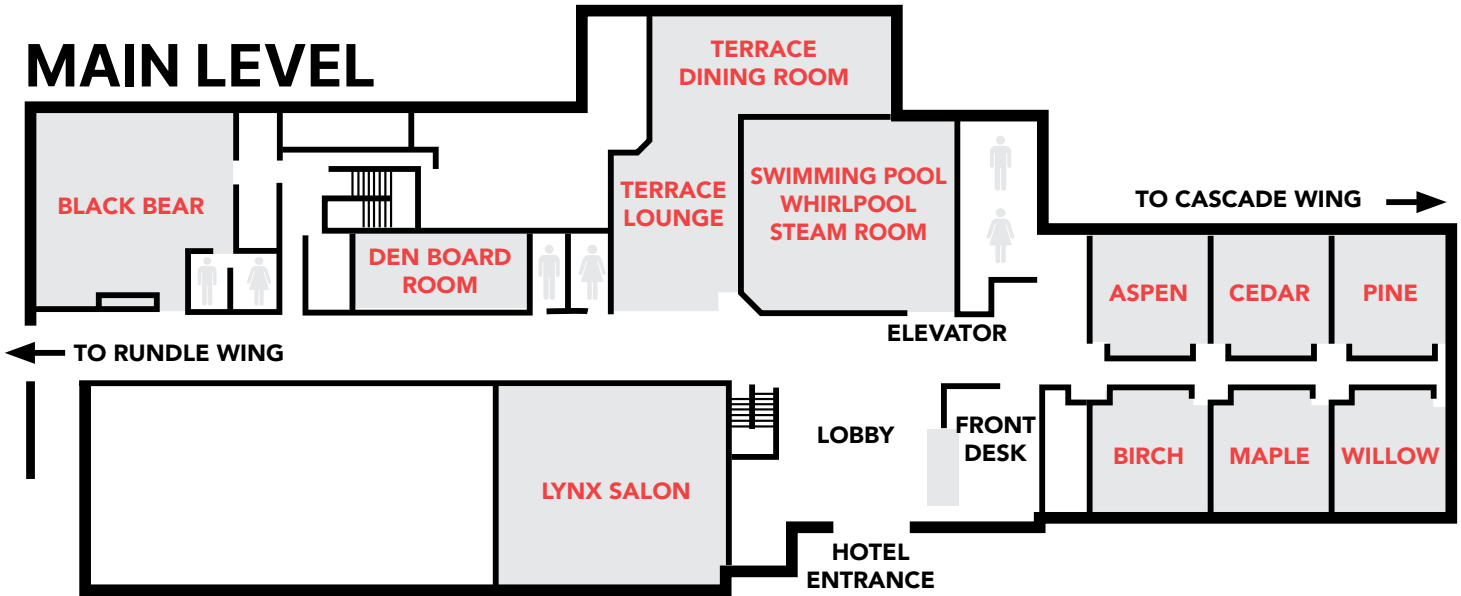

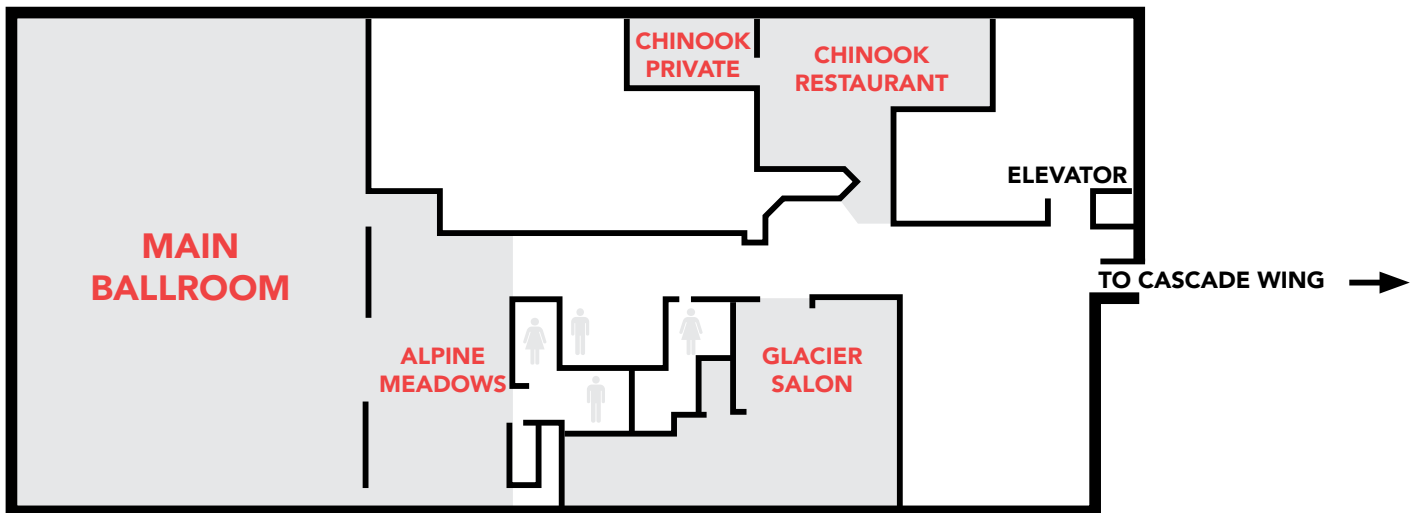

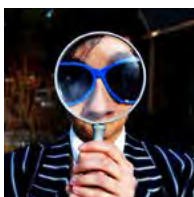
BE OPEN

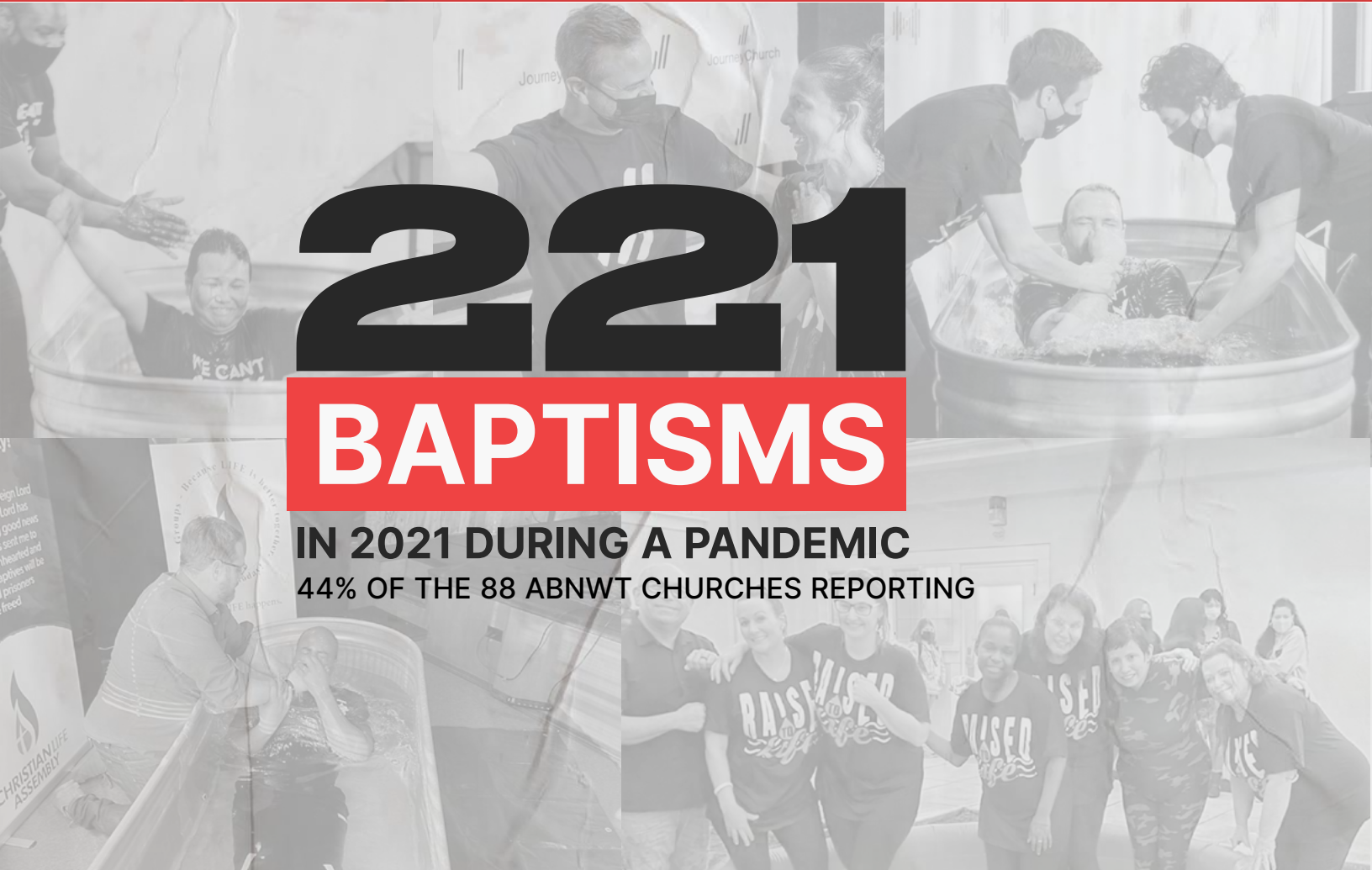
