Description

This scholarship is sponsored by The deGraffenried Foundation and is awarded annually to graduating high school students who are members of the National Art Honor Society looking to pursue a degree in the design industry. Submission Requirements

- i. Application Form
- ii. Current high school transcript
- iii. Portfolio of 10 digital images demonstrating the applicant's artistic ability and sophisticated understanding of design principles. Images must be .JPG format with 300 dpi and largest dimensional side no bigger than 10 inches. Work in the portfolio can include; drawings, sketches, sculpture, photography, graphic design, product design, technical design, or other submissions the applicant deems relevant.
- iv. Letter of recommendation.
- v. Proof of acceptance into a design degree program from a college or university.

Selection

The recipient will be selected by the Board of Directors of The deGraffenried Foundation.

Deadline

Application packages in PDF format are to be emailed to **scholarship@thedf.org** by **April 1, 2022**. The scholarship winner will be announced by June 1, 2022.

Award

The amount of \$7,500 will be awarded to the recipient following the submission of first semester grades as proof of attendance. This scholarship is a one-time award and will be issued directly to the college or university's bursar office.
