- AIA Oregon Board and Executive Committee will consult on key decisions throughout the project, considering input from members, financial matters, the organization's rules, and key information from staff
- AIA Oregon Members will provide critical, guiding input throughout the project
- Consultants will support the project with strategic guidance on specific tasks
