Inspired by the national movement, "A Day Without Childcare," Imagine a Day Without Child Care is a Start Strong PA and Pre-K for PA Provider Advisory Board-led opportunity to engage in advocacy without closing your program. Supported by the Start Strong PA and Pre-K for PA campaigns, the following digital toolkit is intended to be a launching point for provider-led advocacy throughout the month of May.

This toolkit includes:

- Family engagement activities with templates to print out and create a family engagement station.
- · An activity for families on your waiting list.

Social Media Activities for Your Early Learning Program

Use your program's address in the form.

Look up your state representative and state senator on social media so you can tag them in your post. *This is an important step to ensure our message is heard by policymakers*.

Use the following example prompts to raise awareness of *Imagine a Day* Without Child Care on social media (utilize all forms of social media):

Do you own a business? What would the impact be if all your employees called off due to no child care? #SolveChildCare #CareCantWait #DayWithoutChildCare @StartStrongPA

As an ECE professional, I deserve to be paid as such. ECE teachers earn an average of \$29,000 per year. This does NOT cover the cost of living in ANY county in PA. #SolveChildCare #CareCantWait @StartStrongPA

Now is the time to discuss and plan ways to better meet the needs of all young children, families, and early care and education professionals. Unfortunately, 50% of educators in the ECE field reported that they do not plan to, or are unsure of, whether they will remain in their jobs in the next five years. The system is not equitable. Sign on for their elected official

- Parents can complete a simple Action Alert directly from their phone and/or from an iPad (if you have one available for your Family Engagement Station). Ask families to scan the QR Code to complete a quick Action Alert to contact their elected officials.
- Separate action alerts will be available for families who are currently using child care as well as those
 who are on your waiting list.

Grab & Go Stickers (print page 9 on address labels)

 Print stickers that say "I can work because of child care" (from the provided template, using large address labels) and encourage parents to wear them during their work day.
