A cash prize of \$200 will be awarded to the winner

The purpose of the contest is to create artwork for the 2023 Japanese Cultural Fair (JCF). The design may be used in all media – including online, print and other visual collateral. Following are the official contest rules:

- Artwork must be received by the JCF no later than March 3rd, 2023.
- The design must work as a 3-color t-shirt as well as have elements that will work on our poster, postcards and webpage.
- If the artwork utilizes more than 3 colors, the winning entrant must be willing to create a 3-color image from their entry for use on t shirts.
- Individuals may submit no more than one entry, groups no more than two. (A separate entry form must accompany each submission.)
- All submitted artwork must be the original work of the entrant(s) and must not include, be based on, or derived from any pre-existing or third-party designs, trademarks or copywrited images.
- Entry should not be a rough sketch, and no larger than letter size (8.5x11).
- All entries will become the property of the JCF. By submitting an entry, each entrant agrees that any and all intellectual property rights to the design are deemed assigned to the JCF. (The artist will, however, retain the right to use their artwork for personal use, and upon review of the JCF Board, may use the design for financial gain. Questions can be emailed: fabian@jcfsantacruz.org)
- Except where prohibited by law, the name and image of the winner, as well as the winning design entry, may be used by the JCF without any further permission or compensation.
- The JCF reserves the right to modify the winning design (though we would like to work with the artist in doing so).
- All entries will be judged by the JCF board and will be final.
- Artwork **MUST** be delivered digitally in high resolution at 300dpi. PNG, TIFF, PSD and AI/Vector files are all accepted. Vector files should include a JPG export preview. Project must not exceed 10GB. Access to a "Dropbox", "Google Drive", or other online file is acceptable if you are unable to email. If the original art is not digital, please digitize in high resolution. Deliverable must not exceed standard letter 8 1/2 x 11 inches. If the artwork is produced in Photoshop, design element layers, or original file, may be requested. Help may be requested to transfer to digital by emailing: fabian@jcfsantacruz.org
