- The ACI Trampoline Fund supports initiatives that create sustainable and lasting change in society. For instance, empowering vulnerable workers through job guidance and skills training so they can **bounce back and emerge stronger** out of this crisis, supporting disadvantaged children and youth to achieve better educational outcomes, and addressing systemic issues facing migrant workers.

#### **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

A Not-for-Profit entity registered in Singapore as a Society, CLG, Charitable Trust or Co-operative.

**GRANT APPLICATION CLOSING DATE** 

15 July 2020

## **GRANT PROCESS**

1 SUBMIT BRIEF

Applicants are required to submit a brief proposal outlining their project objectives, milestones and implementation plan.

**2** FUND PANEL

The ACI Trampoline Fund panel consisting of representatives from ACI Singapore and The Majurity Trust will evaluate the proposals.

3 EVALUATION

Proposals will be evaluated based on:

- Alignment with the Fund's objectives
- Clarity of the programme objectives
- Feasibility of implementation.

4 APPROVAL

If the application is approved, applicants may receive grant funding of 80% of project costs, up to a cap of \$50,000.

# FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### 1. When is the fund application period?

The application period is 15 June – 15 July 2020.

#### 2. When will application outcome be known?

Applicants will be informed of the outcome in August 2020.

### 3. What are the types of projects that will be supported?

The Fund supports projects and initiative that are address <u>longer-term</u> needs of vulnerable groups beyond the current COVID-19 crisis.

### 4. What are the conditions of the grant?

The programme should commence within 3 months from the approval date. Organisations are required to submit a brief progress report 6 months from the approval date, and an impact report upon completion of the project.

#### 5. What expenses can be supported under the Fund?

The grant can be used for programme related costs such as internal manpower, venue, transport, material and logistics costs. The grant should not be given out as cash or vouchers to beneficiaries.

#### 6. How much funding is provided?

Successful applicants can receive grant funding of up to <u>80% of project costs</u>, <u>capped at \$50,000</u>.

# **7. Can organisations submit more than 1 application to the ACI Trampoline Fund?**Only 1 application is allowed per organisation.

#### 8. How will the funding be disbursed?

The grant will be disbursed in 2 tranches based on the project milestones.
