Lake Oconee Academy (LOA) opened in 2007 as a locally approved public charter school, with eleven kindergarten students. Now including grades PK 4-12 and more than eleven hundred students, with over 30% students of color and 22% on free/reduced lunch (which are not necessarily the same students), LOA has graduated three classes and over 190 alumni. LOA is known for academic excellence, competitive athletics, expressive arts, and students who thrive as scholars and citizens and contribute positively to their communities.

LOA's 50-acre campus sits on Carey Station Road in rural Greensboro, Georgia, halfway between Atlanta and Augusta.

For the 2020-21 school year, LOA graduates were awarded more than \$1.1 million in financial aid, not including the Georgia HOPE and Zell Miller Scholarships.

The LOA High School Faculty is comprised of 35 talented educators, 28 of whom hold advanced degrees, including 2 with doctorates.
