So, if you're struggling to come up with ideas for holiday tech gifts, here are a few tips to help you out:

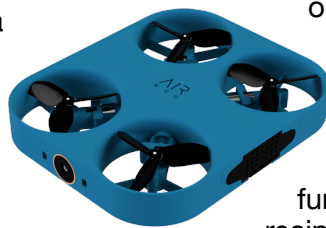
5 Great Holiday Gifts under \$200
