What is a Virtual Memorial?

A virtual memorial is a live gathering of friends and family to remember and celebrate a loved one. Some or all of the attendees join the memorial via video conference call. This guide will explain how you can join a memorial as a virtual attendee using the tool Zoom.

Plan Ahead

Reduce distractions for yourself and other attendees:

- Test your microphone and webcam by clicking here.
- Ensure that you have a stable internet connection:
 - Wired internet is better than wireless (WiFi), if possible.
 - Close unneeded applications on your device.
 - Ask others at home to avoid streaming, large downloads, etc. during the event.
- Find an indoor, quiet environment.
- Plan your attire and background.
- Adjust your lighting so that your face is visible on the screen.
- Honor any requests from the memorial host.


3 OPTIONS TO JOIN THE MEMORIAL

Computer (Desktop or Laptop)



Desktop App


Step 1: Download the Zoom desktop client by clicking <u>here</u>.

2 Mobile Device (Smartphone or Tablet)



Step 1: Download the Zoom app by clicking <u>here</u>.



Step 2: Click the link to your memorial at the scheduled time.

Tips

- Switch between views by swiping the screen left and right.
- Put your camera in frontfacing mode.
- If you leave the app during the memorial, others can still hear you speak but your video will pause until you open the app.
- If the control bar is not visible at the bottom of the screen, tap the screen to view it again.

Traditional Phone
(Audio Only)



Step 1: At the scheduled time of your memorial, dial one of the teleconferencing numbers included in the invitation.

Step 2: When prompted, enter the meeting ID number using your dialpad.



You may choose to dial in by phone for audio and use a computer or mobile device for the visual portion.
