7-Day Prayer Guide: The Way of Abundances

Introduction: As followers of Christ, we are called to pray fervently and intentionally for those in need. This guide is designed to help you pray for people with disabilities, Accessible Hope International (AHI), and our Global Hope Partners (GHPs) by focusing on seven key domains that reflect the fullness of life —spiritual, social/relational, emotional, economic, physical, intellectual, and dignity & purpose. As we lift these prayers, we embrace "The Way of Abundance," recognizing that God's abundant life is meant for all people, including those with disabilities.

Each day, focus on one domain, using the scriptures and prayer points provided. May this time of prayer open our hearts to the abundant life Christ offers and deepen our commitment to being His hands and feet in the world.

Sunday - Spiritual

"...but grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. To Him be the glory, both now and to the day of eternity. Amen." – 2 Peter 3:18

- Pray for greater access for people with disabilities to the hope found in the Gospel.
- Pray that many children and adults with disabilities would find abundant life in Christ.
- Pray that AHI's disciple-makers would not grow weary in doing good.
- Pray that all AHI leaders and GHPs will be deeply formed in their walk with Jesus.
- Pray that the Church would welcome people with disabilities into true fellowship and belonging.

Monday - Social/Relational

"God is not unjust; he will not forget your work and the love you have shown him as you have helped his people and continue to help them." – Hebrews 6:10

- Pray for people with disabilities to experience healing and restoration in their relationships.
- Pray for unity in ministry teams providing discipleship and education.
- Pray for more partnerships to support and uplift the disability community.
- Pray that the global Church would fully embrace people with disabilities as integral members.

Tuesday - Emotional

"Come to me, all who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest..." – Matthew 11:28-30

- Pray for people with disabilities to experience emotional healing and peace.
- Pray that families would overcome fear and stigma, boldly embracing their loved ones with disabilities.
- Pray that ministry leaders would serve from a place of emotional health and joy.
- Pray that people with disabilities would be seen as co-laborers in God's Kingdom.

Wednesday - Economic

"Who provides food for the raven when its young cry out to God and wander about for lack of food?" – Job 38:41

- Pray for sustainable livelihoods for people with disabilities.
- Pray for 50 new financial partners to support AHI's mission in 2025.
- Pray for successful income-generating projects for the Global Hope Partners of Accessible Hope International.
- Pray for the financial resources needed to expand and sustain the ministry efforts of Accessible Hope.

Thursday - Physical

"The Sovereign LORD is my strength; he makes my feet like the feet of a deer, he enables me to tread on the heights." – Habakkuk 3:19

- Pray for strength and health for people with disabilities and their caregivers.
- Pray for the completion of school buildings in Sierra Leone and Tanzania.
- Pray for improved accessibility in churches and communities.
- Pray for the provision of daily needs like food, shelter, and medical care for people with disabilities.

Friday - Intellectual

"The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom; all who follow his precepts have good understanding." – Psalm 111:10

- Pray for access to education and skill development for people with disabilities.
- Pray for wisdom for AHI leaders as they steward resources and plan for the future.
- Pray for the spread of biblical resources in accessible formats.
- Pray that more people with disabilities will be empowered to contribute to their communities.

Saturday - Dignity & Purpose

"Are not two sparrows sold for a penny? Yet not one of them will fall to the ground outside your Father's care... So don't be afraid; you are worth more than many sparrows." – Matthew 10:29-31

- Pray that people with disabilities will know their worth in God's eyes.
- Pray for protection from exploitation and discrimination.
- Pray for a shift in societal attitudes, recognizing the value of all people.
- Pray for boldness among ministry leaders advocating for dignity and justice.
