Incidents from September 23, 2020 through October 6, 2020

- **September 25th at 0851 hours**, Officer took a burglary report in the 21700 block of Evergreen Trail. Suspect entered an open garage overnight and stole over one-thousand dollars in property.
- **September 25th at 0940 hours**, Officer took a burglary report in the 14100 block of Northdale Boulevard. A lock was cut on a fenced cage attached to the business and its contents were removed.
- **September 25th at 0953 hours**, Officer took a fraud report from business in the 21800 block of industrial Boulevards. Multiple fraudulent checks in the businesses name were being written out and cashed. The issue has been ongoing since May. Rogers detectives are investigating.
- **September 25th at 1712 hours**, Officer was dispatched to a theft from auto report that occurred at a residence located in the 14000 block of Teal Court. Officer spoke with the reporting party who had \$400 worth of gym gear stolen from the inside of her vehicle parked at the residence. The vehicle was parked inside the garage overnight and the door was believed to have been left open.
- **September 25th at 1806 hours**, Officer was dispatched to a theft report at a business located in the 20800 block of Rogers Drive. Officer met with an employee who reported the theft of a Stihl Saw valued at \$409.99. The suspect concealed the item in another box only purchasing the one item. The suspect, a 42-year-old male from Minneapolis was mailed a citation for theft by swindle.
- **September 26th at 1511 hours**, Officers were dispatched to a road rage weapon pointing incident that occurred on I-94 and the off-ramp to Main Street in Rogers. Officers checked the area but were unable to locate the vehicle. Victim was able to capture a picture of suspect vehicle before it turned in the opposite direction of the victim. Rogers detectives are investigating.
- **September 27th at 0313 hours**, Officer stopped vehicle for expired registration Main Street near I-94. Driver gave officer her sister's name and date of birth. Driver admitted to giving a false name. The driver, a 30-year-old female from Onamia, arrested for false info and multiple felony warrants. The passenger also gave officer a false name. The 20-year-old female passenger from Onamia, was arrested for a felony warrant and cited for false info.
- **September 28th at 1148 hours**, Resident came to the Rogers Police Department to report an attempted scam. Reporting party indicated the Government was calling indicating his social security number was comprised and needed to send them money. Reporting party did not provide party any information.
- **September 30th at 1246 hours**, Officer was dispatched to a traffic complaint of a vehicle all over the road coming into Rogers on southbound Main Street. The reporting party followed the vehicle as it exited 141st Avenue and pulled into a parking lot. Officer located the vehicle and made contact with the driver and passenger. Officer observed the two people attempting to use narcotics. The passenger, a 26-year-old female from Maple Grove and driver a 30-year-old male from Askov, was arrested for possession of a controlled substance and transported to Hennepin County jail.

The driver of the vehicle the female suspect had gotten a ride in, was cited for possession of drug paraphernalia.
