## **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION**

- \*\*Freshmen students have the option to register for either Algebra I OR Geometry
- Physical Education requirement is 5 credits per year for four years (to be fulfilled outside of Mater Dei)
- Fine Arts requirement is 5 credits per year for two years (to be fulfilled outside of Mater Dei)
- · Completion of full Mater Dei Curriculum as outlined above will fulfill requirements for Magna Cum Laude high school diploma (260 credits)
- For reference, admission to University of Minnesota-TC requires:
  - · Additional year of Math (not elective, as in the Mater Dei program)
  - Biological science, chemistry, and physics are required (physics not elective, as in the Mater Dei program) for admission to the Carlson School of Management, Biological Sciences, and Science and Engineering.
