SEMI-FORMAL DRESS CODE



GENERAL DEFINITION

Semi-formal attire is an outfit that is dressier than what you would wear to an office but not as dressy as a formal evening gown or tuxedo. If the event is held in the evening (after 6:00 pm), the semi-formal guidelines lean more toward the formal than if it were held during the day. Semi-formal attire is typically worn to weddings, holiday parties, and fine restaurants.

EVENT- SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS

Attire for guys and ladies should be clean, well-pressed and fitted modestly. If undergarment lines are visible beneath the clothing, it is too tight. Students must adhere to the event-specific requirements in order to participate in this event. Unsure if your outfit meets the guidelines? LADIES

- Below-the-knee dress or skirt (no slits above the knee)
- Back and shoulders must be covered
- No exposed cleavage (check when bending over)
- Heels, strappy sandals or dressy flats
- Subtle fashion jewelry (optional)
- Scarf, shawl or wrap (optional)

GUYS

- Collared, long-sleeve dress shirt
- Tie or bow tie
- Dark colored suit coat or sport coat (optional)
- Dark colored dress pants (no jeans)
- · Dark colored socks
- Dark belt and dress shoes (no sneakers)
- Dress hat (optional)
