FOR WATERCOLOR BASICS

NECESSARY FOR CLASS

WATERCOLOR PAINTS

My favorites are Schmincke Horadam paints sold in pans. We also sell Schmincke paint in our kits. (at the bottom of this page)

Another brand I love is Sennelier, and if you are looking for a more affordable option, I recommend Windor & Newton Cotman watercolors.

The exact Schmincke colors I am using for the color mixing portion of this class:

101 Titanium Opaque White	479 Helio Cerulean
216 Pure Yellow	780 Ivory Black
352 Magenta	

PAINTBRUSH

I recommend a size 4 round brush. My favorite is a Neptune Synthetic Squirrel Brush from Princeton.

WATERCOLOR PAPER

You can use loose sheets of watercolor paper or a sketchbook with watercolor paper.

For this course you'll want cold press watercolor paper. Some good brands are Strathmore, Canson, and Legion.

WATER CUP & A CLOTH OR PAPER TOWEL

You'll need a container for your water. I love to use repurposed glass jars or other empty containers. The cloth or paper towel is for cleaning and drying your brush.

NICE-TO-HAVE

(but not 100% necessary)

FINELINER PEN

Like a Micron or Staedtler pen in size 01

WHITE GEL PEN

My favorite is a Uni-ball Signo White Gel Pen

PENCIL

KNEADED ERASER

RULER
