The Worth Parish Centre

The Worth Centre gives us a central point of operations. Through the old wooden door on the right you can step into the church. The open door directly ahead leads outside. Moving along, to the left of the store cupboard, you can see in the corner double doors leading into the upper hall. On the left you can see a door into the kitchen and if you turned further to your left you would see doors to the WCs and almost behind you doors leading down into the lower hall. Above you can see the lantern roof, which maximises our natural light. At times this room might be a thorough-fare for access, picking up a cup of tea, popping to the loo; at other times it would itself be a focus of activity, perfect for hosting a drinks reception or as a gallery space. As the bridge between the Victorian church and contemporary buildings, it will have character, access to modern facilities, and flexibility. And, as both a point of connection and a hospitality and meeting space in its own right, the Worth Centre creates a new and much needed asset for the parish.
