Methodology

This poll was conducted between June 13^{th} and 15^{th} , 2020. In all, 500 interviews were achieved among likely 2020 General Election voters in New Hampshire. 150 of these responses came from cell phones. The Margin of Error for this survey is +/- 4.38% at a Confidence Interval of 95%.
