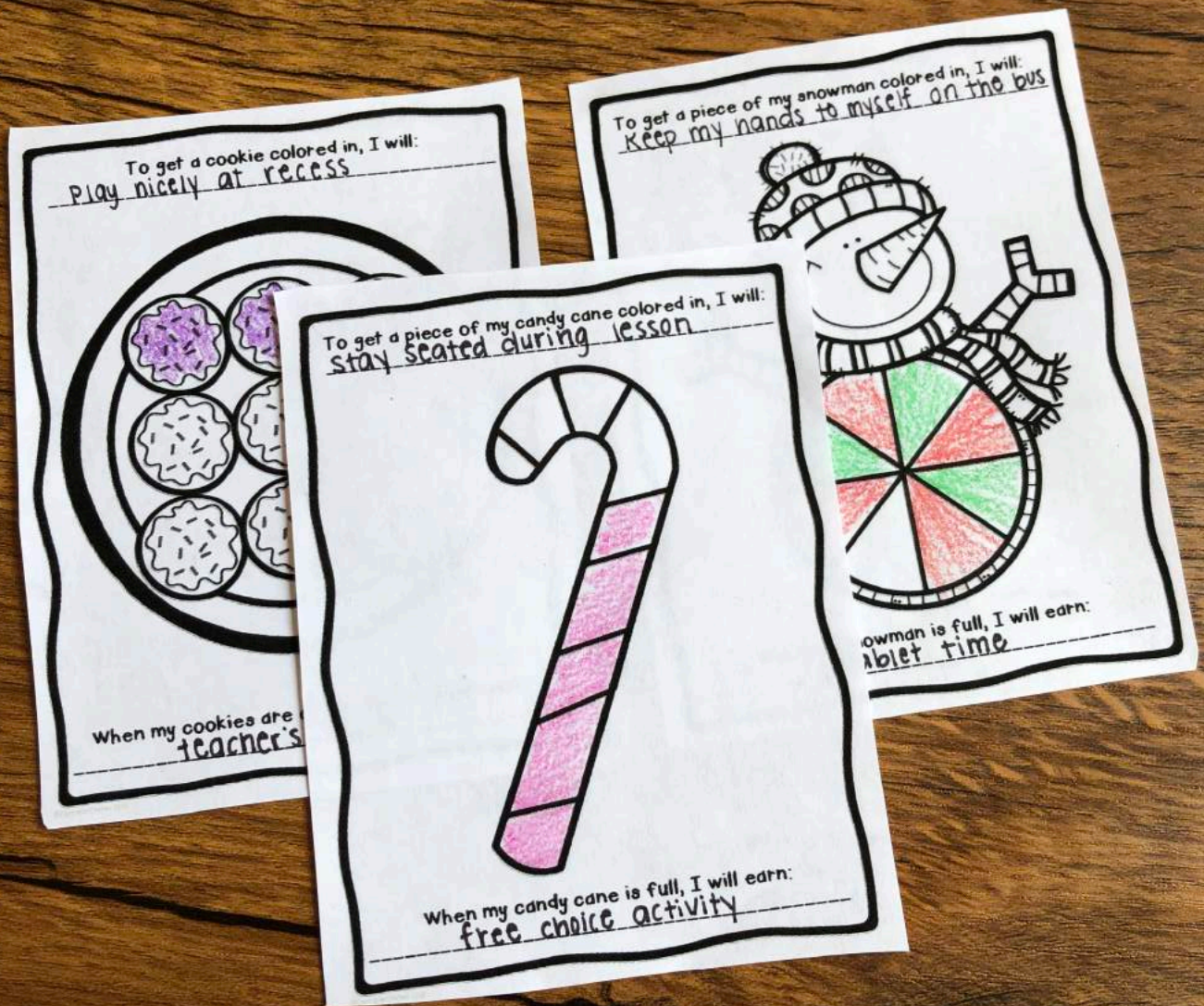

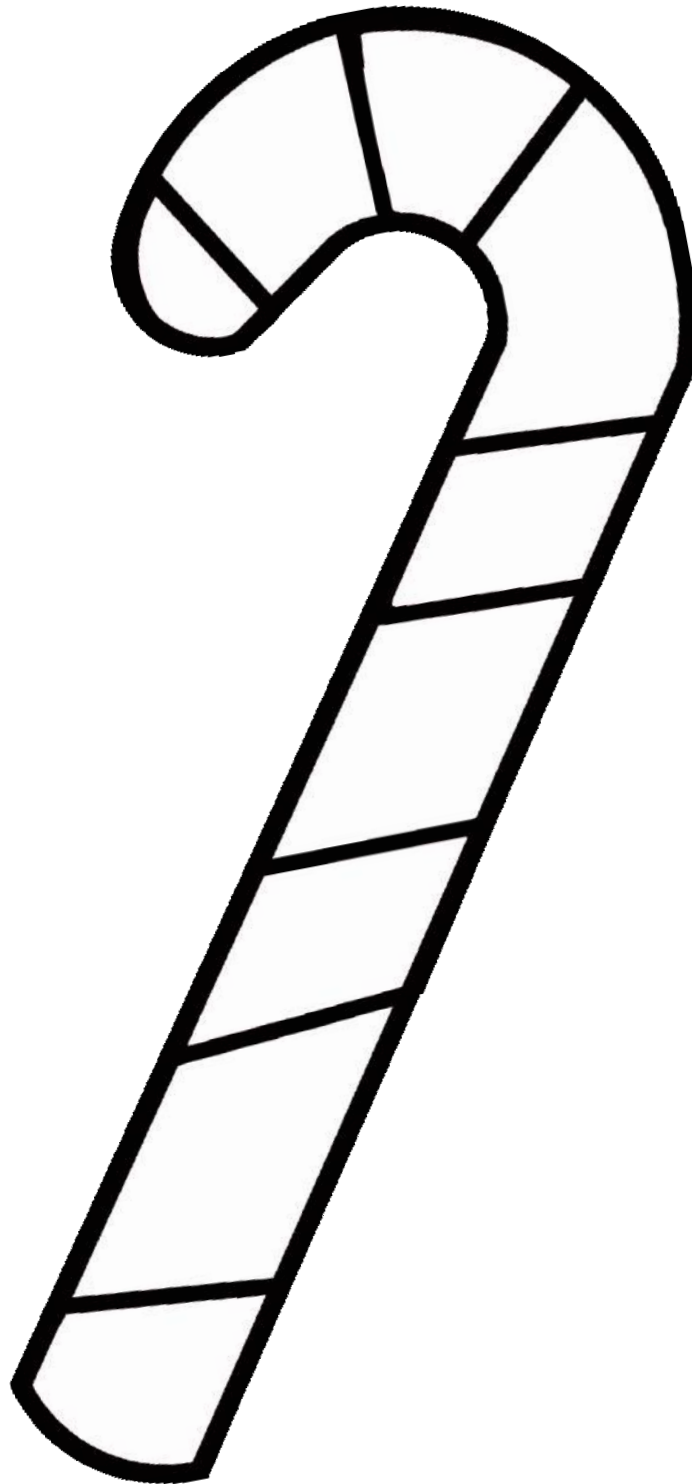
Directions:

Ideas for rewards include:

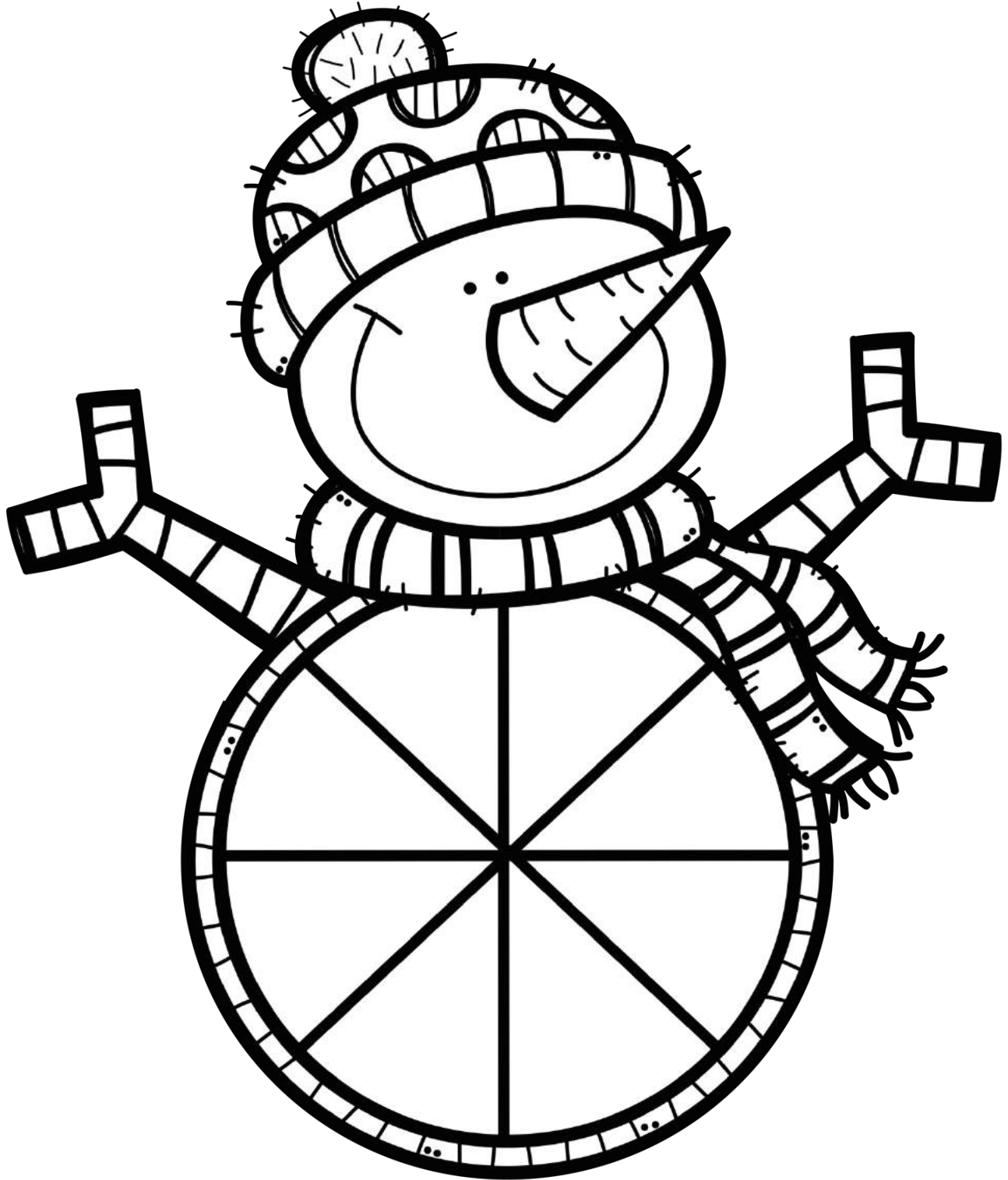
- Game time

To get a piece of my candy cane colored in, I will:



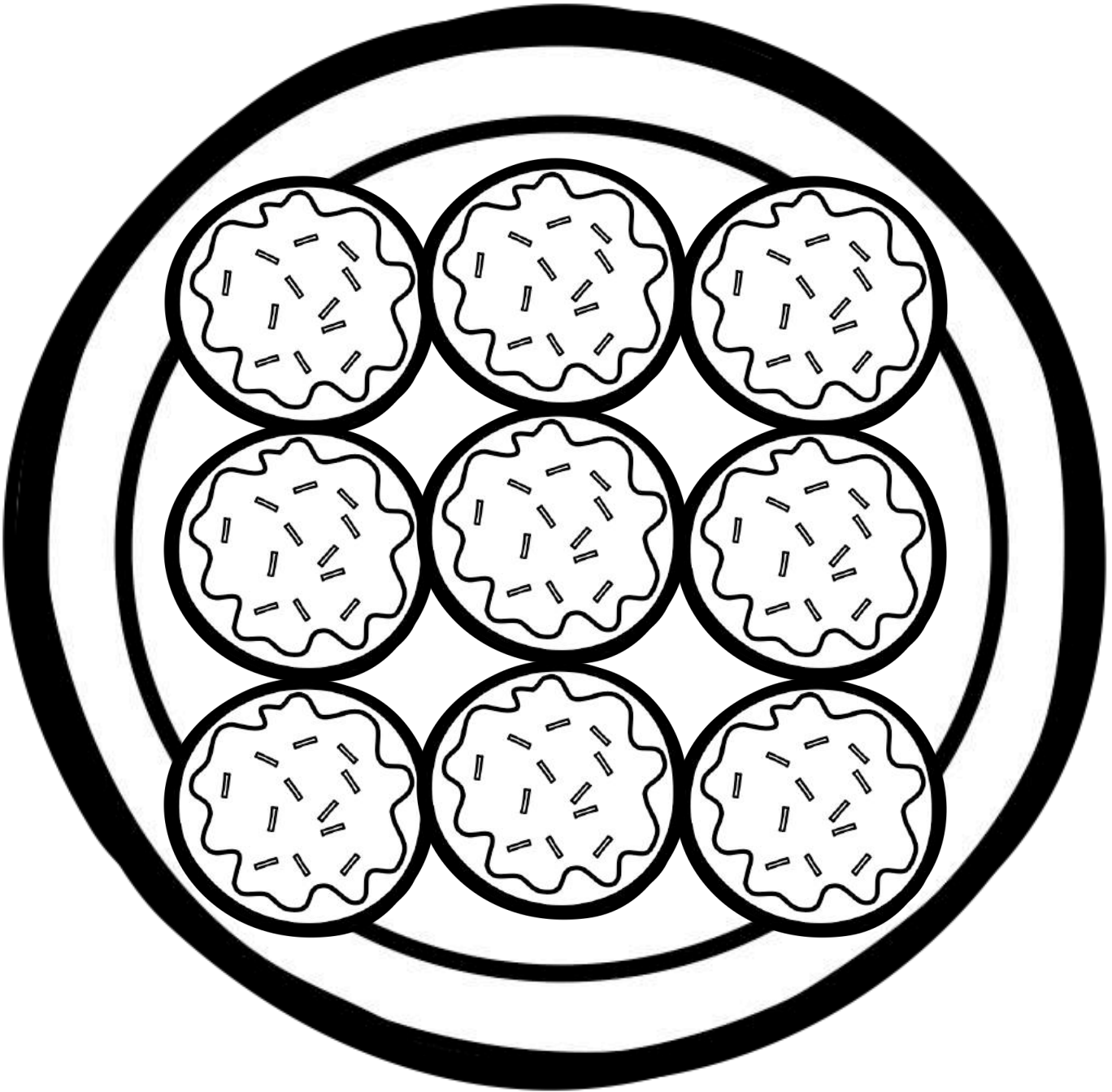
When my candy cane is full, I will earn:

When my snowman is full, I will earn:

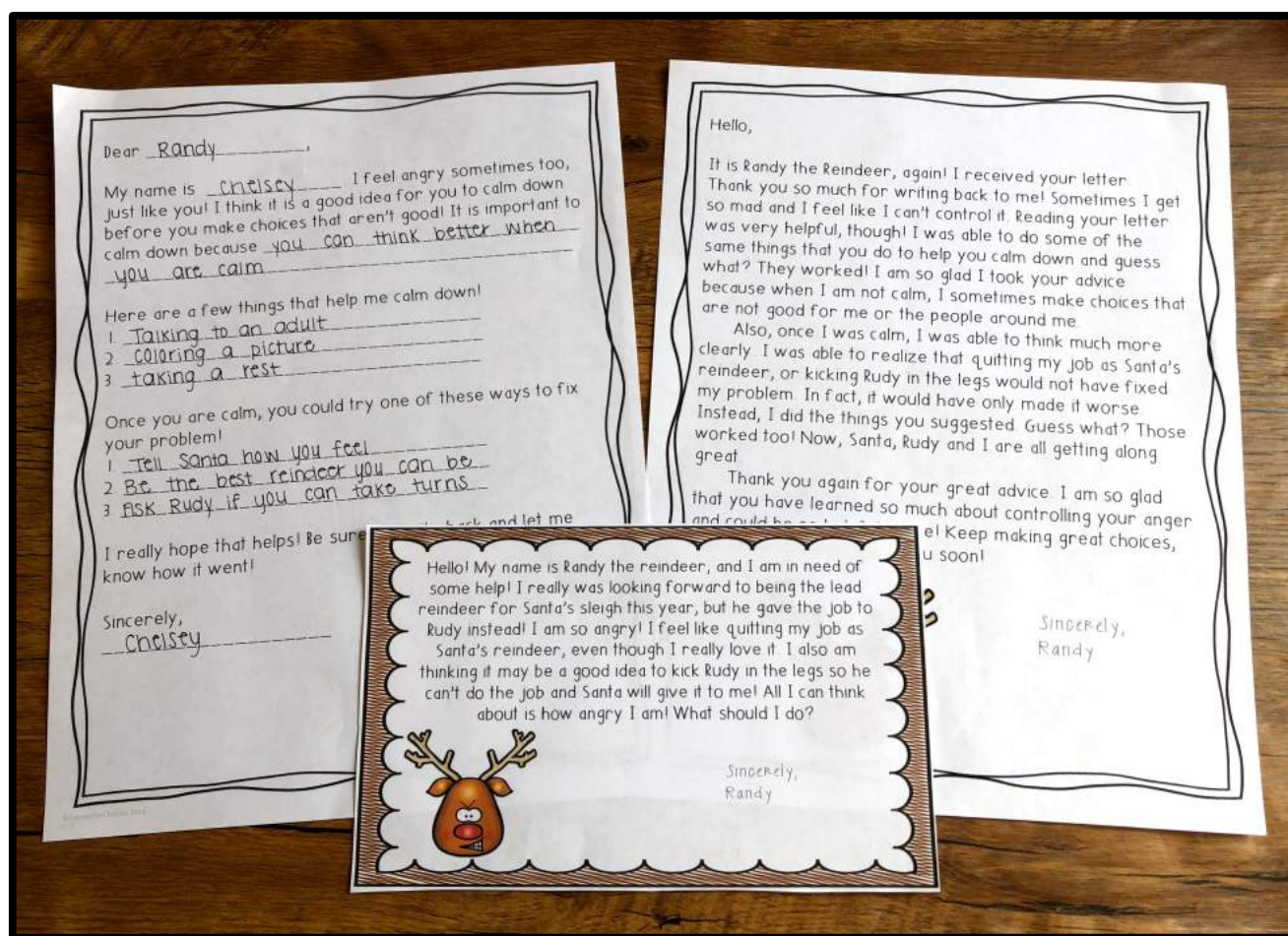
To get a cookie colored in, I will:
