HOUSING

If a patient is <u>literally homeless</u> as HUD defines "homeless" as "a person sleeping in a place **not** meant for human habitation (e.g. living on the streets for example) OR living in a homeless emergency shelter. Grey Area: this may include a person living in an RV only if they are missing one of the necessary utilities defining residence; example: RV with water and electric but no sewer or RV with sewer and water but no electric is considered homeless.

Not Considered Homeless:

- Couch-surfing
- Staying in a motel
- Staying at a family member's house, even if it's only temporary.

If the person is <u>literally homeless</u>, they or the clinician can call the <u>Community Housing Network Homeless Hotline</u> @ **509-888-9035** for an over-the-phone intake. The person will be scored and placed in a housing pool.

Make sure the patient has an active phone number, if they are called and don't answer, they are skipped and off the list.

There is little to NO funding right now. It will take at least 7 - 12 months to get assistance for housing. There is no funding for at-risk of homeless at this time as well.
