1 John 2:15-17

NOTES:

Focus Passage

1 John 2:15 Do not love the world or the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him. **16** For all that is in the world—the desires of the flesh and the desires of the eyes and pride of life—is not from the Father but is from the world. **17** And the world is passing away along with its desires, but whoever does the will of God abides forever.

James 4:4 You adulterers! Don't you realize that friendship with the world makes you an enemy of God? I say it again: If you want to be a friend of the world, you make yourself an enemy of God. (NLT)

 - **Psalm 139:23** Search me, O God, and know my heart; test me and know my anxious thoughts. **24** Point out anything in me that offends you and lead me along the path of everlasting life. (NLT)
 - **Proverbs 28:13** *People who conceal their sins will not prosper, but if they confess and turn from them, they will receive mercy.* (NLT)
