

# CROCHETED CRITTER

## P A T T E R N



## MATERIALS

Yarn  
Soft Stuffing  
Thread  
Buttons, 2x  
Stitch Markers

## TOOLS

Scissors  
Crochet Hook  
J/10-6.00MM  
Sewing Needle

## ABBREVIATIONS (US TERMS)

\* = repeat  
ch = chain stitch  
sc = single crochet stitch  
sk = skip (a stitch)  
sl st = slip stitch  
st(s) = stitch(es)



## BODY

**Rnd 01:** Ch 3, sl st to join to make a ring.

**Rnd 02:** Ch 2, 1 sc into ring (5), sl st to join.

**Rnd 03:** Ch 2, 1 sc into next ch. (7), sl st to join.

**Rnd 04:** Ch 2, 1 sc in next ch, sk ch, \*2 sc into next ch.\* (16), sl st to join.

**Rnds 05-10:** Ch 2, sk ch, sc in next chain (16), sk ch, sl st to join.

## EYES

Sew them in before you add stuffing for a smoother finish. You will see that the ch 2 column will be visible on the left side to indicate the surface facing you is the front.

Add soft stuffing to fill before closing it.

## BODY (CONTINUED)

**Rnd 11:** Ch 2, \*sk, 1 sc\* (8), sl st to join.

**Rnd 12:** Ch 2, \*sk, 1 sc\* (4), sl st to join.

## TENTACLES

Still connected, \*ch 7, sc back to first st (7), sc into body\* (8), sl st to end off.

If the legs look a bit flat, you can pinch/fold the ends to give that curl.
