ECW Thrift House



The Episcopal Church Women (ECW) operate the Thrift House, a Christian nonprofit organization selling donated merchandise. St. Michael's, Grace/St. Stephen's, and Chapel of Our Savior own and run the Thrift House with mostly volunteers and a small paid staff. Profits

are divided up between these churches and used for outreach. Closed for over 3 months during the pandemic, we re-opened to only 3 days a week due to the loss of most volunteers. Recently re-opening on Wednesdays, it will be very difficult filling St. Mike's obligations for the upcoming months.

Volunteers are needed from 10:00 AM - 1:00 PM or 1:00 - 4:00 PM on rotating days. Volunteers will run the cash register (only if you feel comfortable in doing so), put out clothing or housewares, steam clothes, assist customers, and have fun! Getting to know the

other volunteers and customers is great. We have many returning customers who love shopping with us.

Precautions taken include wiped down surfaces and a plexiglass at the counter. If fully vaccinated, masks are optional. For more information

Family Promise/IHN Update September 12 "Host Week"

St. Michael's has partnered with the Interfaith Hospitality Network (IHN) ministry for 17 years, sheltering up to four homeless families twice a year for a week at a time. While hosting, our parishioners along with those from St. Francis Catholic Church, have graciously volunteered their time and talent to provide food, fellowship, and a warm and safe place for the families to sleep while they worked to get back on their feet.

When the pandemic hit, IHN (through Family Promise) suspended in-church hostings. Family Promise staff vacated and re-purposed their offices in the Day House to create bedrooms for the homeless families and Network churches have been providing supplies and dinners for the families instead of hosting them at their churches.

St. Michael's next scheduled (non-in-church) IHN hosting week starts September 12, 2021.

Update from Mercy's Gate 2020 Annual Report

Serving 15,700 people in El Paso County, key points from the 2020 Annual Report include: Total Income exceeded \$1.87 million, including \$657,627 "In Kind" – including food and toiletries donations from St. Michael's, total Expenses were more than \$1.3 million, with Health & Food Security, Seasonal Programs (e.g., Thanksgiving Meal Baskets and Back to School Supply Drive), and Utilities and Rent Assistance the top expense categories, and general administrative expenses and fundraising constituted 18% of total expenses and 12% of income.



Ministry Highlights

206 households served through the Utilities Assistance program.
276 households remained in their homes through the Housing Assistance program.
14,143 people benefitted from the Mercy's Gate food market.
102 households received medical and health cost assistance.
397 households received clothing vouchers.

Property Updates & Upgrades

"Equipping our building for ministry ..."

Earlier this year Matt and the vestry laid out several ambitious goals. One of these goals focused on how we can equip our building for ministry and maximize the way we use our space. With the help of staff and volunteers we tackled an ambitious *Spring Cleaning* project that filled two 40 yard dumpsters with broken furniture, damaged toys, and countless treasures that have been collecting dust for decades. With our rooms and spaces clear of clutter new ideas, hopes, and dreams began to emerge. One of the first projects tackled by our Spiritual Directors was clearing out the unused library to create a new Prayer Room that doubles as a meeting space, sacred space, and spiritual direction room.



In the recent weeks we've had parishioners patch holes, paint walls, and repurpose old furniture. We've moved St. Bede's bookstore to the hallway going into the church offices. And in the coming weeks we will have the carpets steam cleaned in the entire building, add new TV monitors to several areas, decorate class rooms, furnish the nursery with new toys, add outdoor furniture to the plaza, and continue to reimagine ways to better use our space to serve you and our community.

If you are wondering *why* and *how* all this work is getting done, the short answer is "you" and "you." Your generosity through pledged giving and one-time donations has allowed us to fund this work while leveraging volunteers to do as much as possible. As we prepare to return inside in September, we are looking forward to using more of our building and in new ways!

St. Michael's Legacy honors those who choose to make St. Michael's part of their legacy by including St. Michael's in their will or estate planning. Planned giving, as it is often called, helps to ensure that our mission - to make Christ known within and beyond our walls –

continues. Planned giving is separate from the annual stewardship campaign, which funds the yearly operating expenses of our parish.

The Endowment is managed by a Vestry-appointed Endowment Committee. Current members include Steve Caruthers (Chair), Nancy Jones, Scott Callihan, Bob Kean, and Linda Dameron; Amy de Lourenco is the Vestry Liaison. A special thank you go our outgoing chair Jim Moore and his years of encouragement and leadership with our Endowment. As of the end of the first quarter (March 31, 2021) the balance in our Endowment Fund was \$245,106. *All funds are invested in the Vanguard STAR Fund, a "fund of funds" comprising selections from Vanguard's menu of low-expense mutual funds.*

Organ Update

Did you know St. Michael's organ uses a computer to make music? Each time a key is pressed on the organ console a electric signal enters a relay system that sends another signal to one of our 3,000 pipes. Over the past year it has become clear that our current computer (running Windows 98) and the relay system needs to be upgraded. Over the past six months our Organ Committee has been working with various vendors to receive quotes to perform the work necessary. The initial quotes indicate we will need to make a substantial (fivefigure) investment to ensure our beautiful organ will continue to enhance our worship experiences at St. Michael's. 
